World's Fair can't pay rent

NEW ORLEANS — The financially crumbling World's Fair defaulted on rent owed the state for the expo's Great Hall, which houses the Louisiana Journey boat ride and a variety of other popular exhibits.

The Exhibition Hall Authority owns the building and plans to convert it into a new city convention center after the fair closes Nov. 11.

The fair owes the authority almost \$380,000 for rent in September and October, insurance, salaries and changes made in the structure, said

Joseph Berrigan Jr., the authority's attorney.

The default will not affect daily operations at the fair, and the fair will not be evicted from the Great Hall or sued for the money, Berrigan said.

Formal notice of default simply assures the authority will not be overlooked when a plan is devised to pay the fair's creditors, who are owed a total of about \$140 million, he said.

However, he did not rule out a future lawsuit if a payment plan is not worked out.

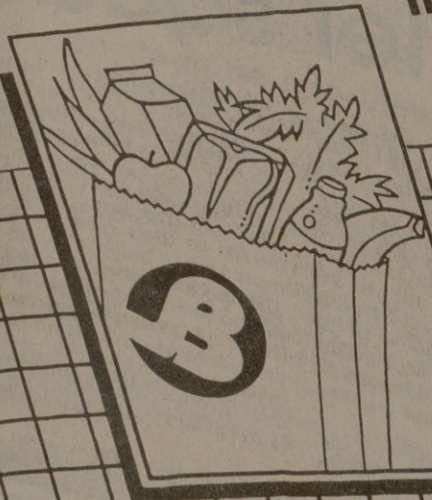
