

Astronaut will speak on religion

NASA astronaut Dr. Don Leslie Lind will speak in Rudder 701 Saturday at 7 p.m.

The speech, sponsored by the Latter-Day Saint Student Association, is titled: "Science and Religion." Lind, a commander in the U.S. Naval Reserve, was the back-up science pilot for both the second and third manned Skylab missions.

Lind has been designated by NASA to serve as a mission specialist on a space lab mission scheduled later this month.

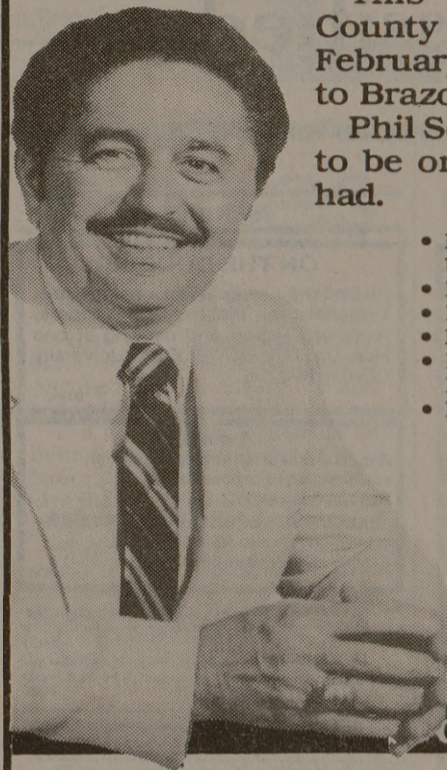

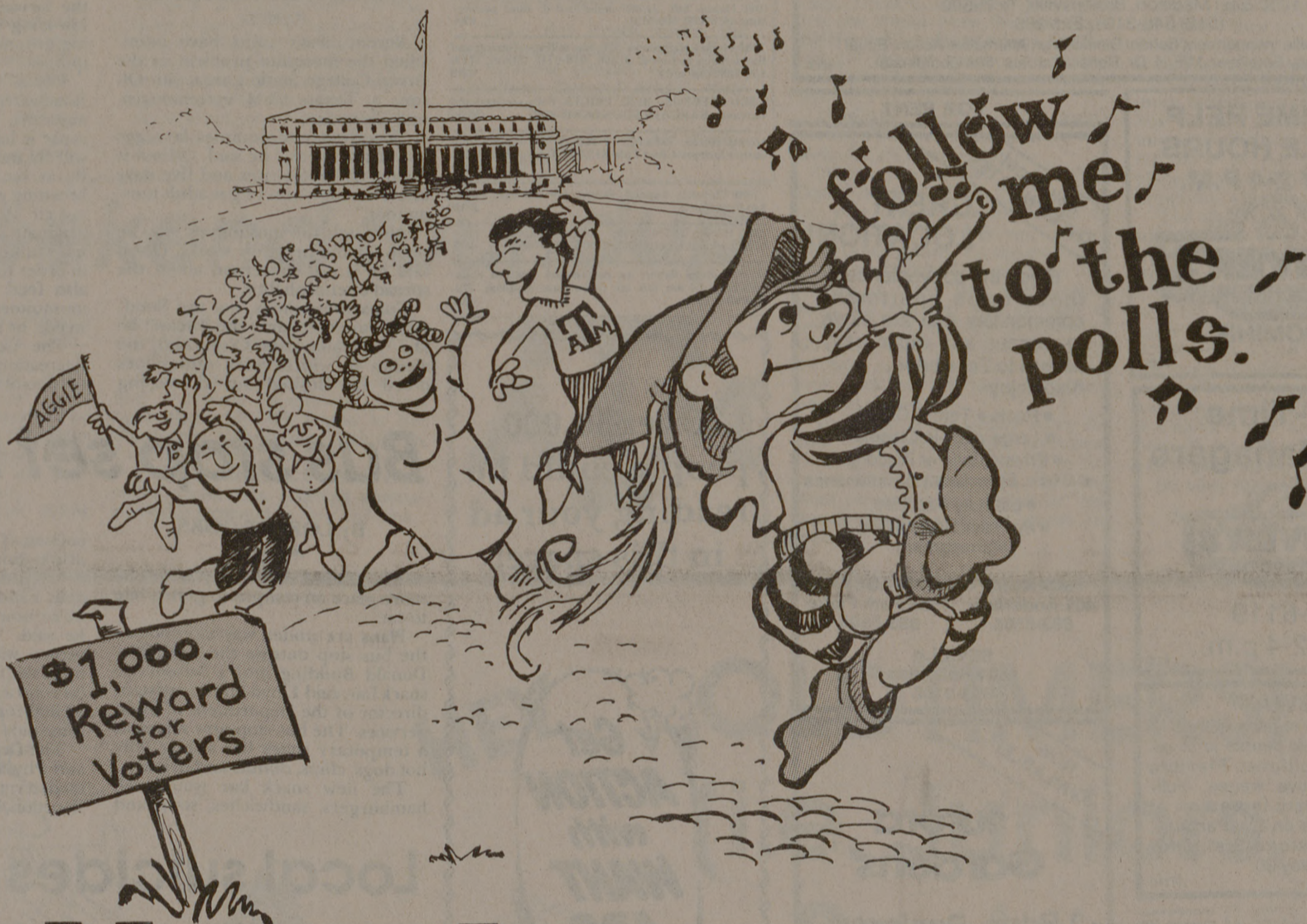
