Rev. Falwell encourages GOP vote

LYNCHBURG, Va. — Majority founder Jerry Falwell exhorted his followers Sunday for the spiritual awakening of America and vote for candidates who pose "our national sin" of abortion.

Falwell was careful not to name President Reagan by name, but marks to his Lynchburg congregation of 3,000 and to the national audience of The Old Gospel Hour.

However, the Moral Majority agenda and Republican Party form a dovetail in opposing abortion and the nuclear freeze. Falwell favors constitutional amendments to outlaw abortion and prayer to public schools and tuition to grant tuition tax credit for Christian schools.

Falwell said the re-election of Reagan would mean "the major national sins could be dealt with in the next four years."

He called abortion "a biblical holocaust" that has resulted in the "murder" of 10 million unborn children.

Telephone banks will attempt to get out the vote on election day. Students from Liberty Baptist College — which Falwell founded — were sent to North Carolina to support Republican Sen. Jesse Helms, who has shared the pulpit with Falwell.

San Francisco polling place to serve patrons

SAN FRANCISCO — Bob Pritikin, owner of the Mansion restaurant, will serve truffles and pate at the polls he calls America's poshest polling place.

"Tuesday will be our first presidential election," Pritikin said. "Voters will be treated to complimentary parking and food prepared by the hotel's master chef."

"I'll do red, white and blue caviar, truffles and my special venison and juniperberry pate," Coyle said. "Will there be a charge?"

"Of course not," said Pritikin. "That would be a poll tax."

"Why should the citizens vote in smelly garages?" Pritikin said. "Voting should be fun and inspirational."

Voters will cast ballots under ornate chandeliers in a setting of antiques, oriental rugs and collections of fine art.

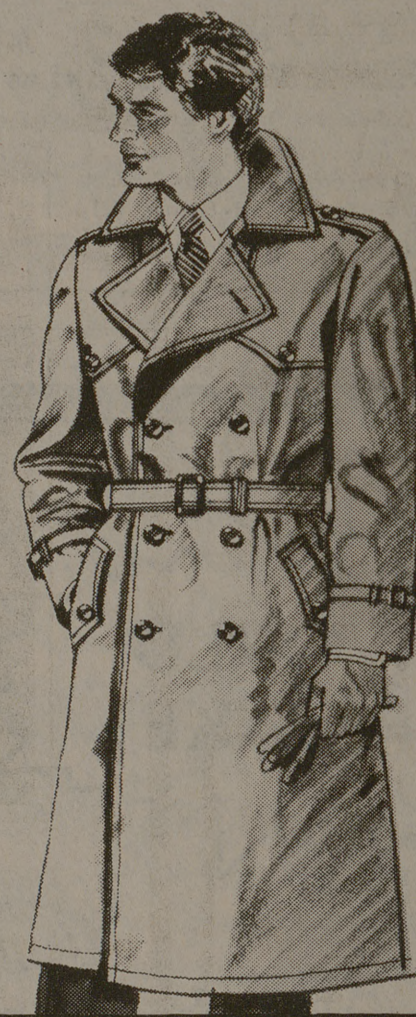
