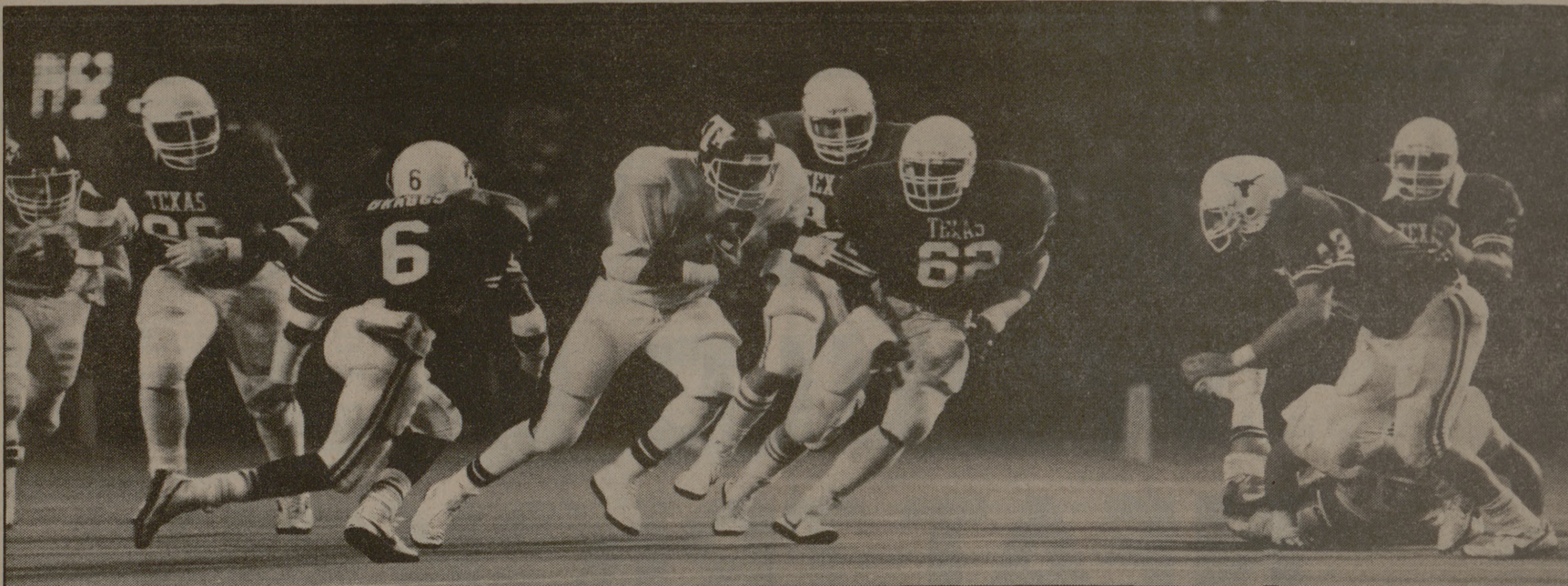
Sherrill's second ride in as many weeks; last week the Ags stunned TCU, knocking them from the Cotton Bowl picture.

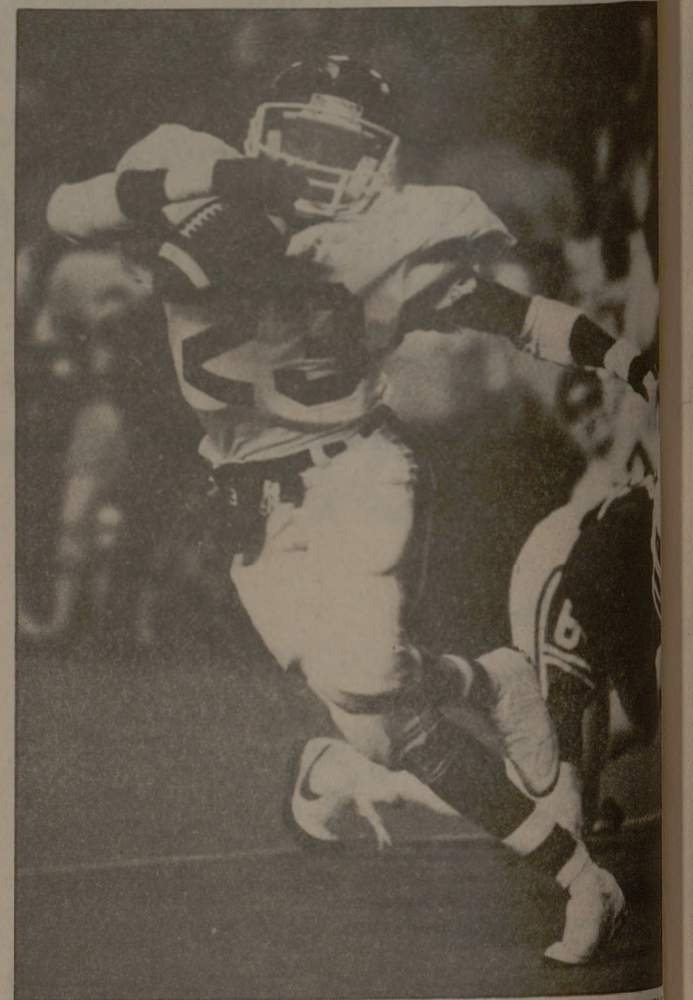

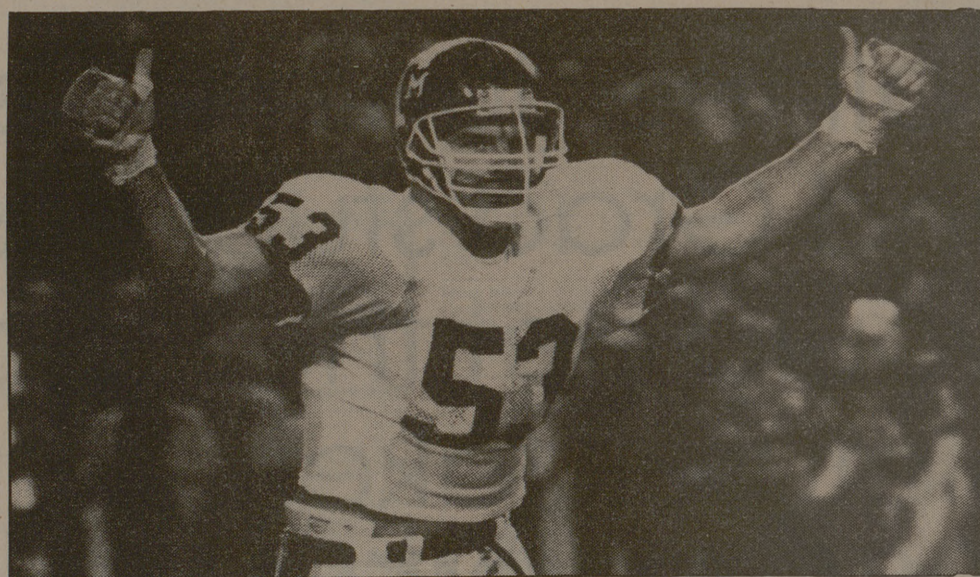

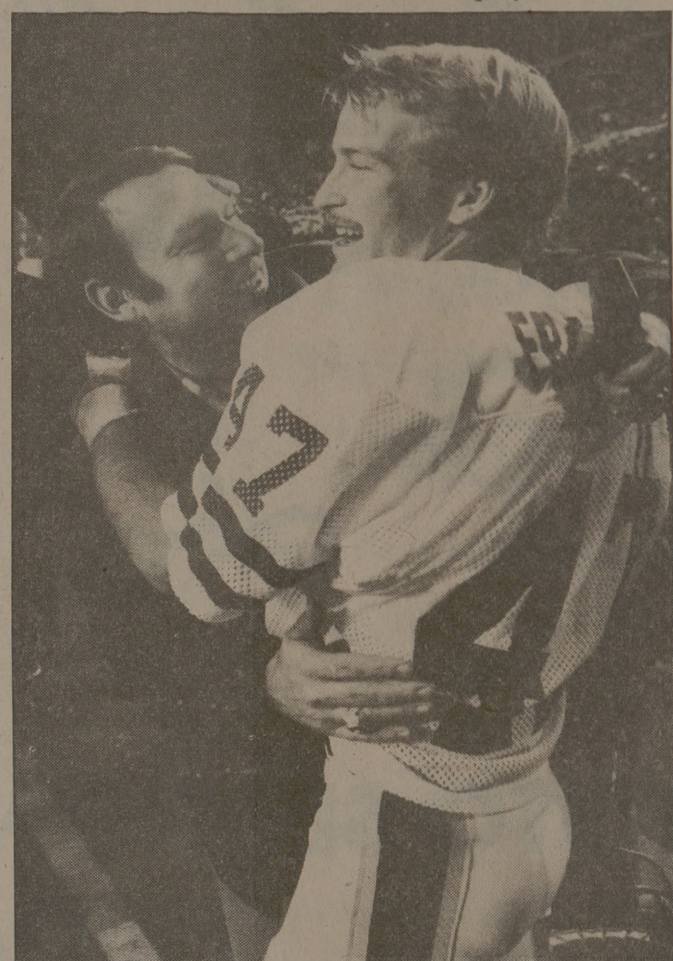
