looked like little blue-jeaned, high-tech spacemen waddling over to the plane to pose for the At Ease photographer.

The heavy pack made it difficult to scoot backwards into the tiny two-person plane, but five of us managed to squeeze in. We held our static lines in a death grip as the plane took off.

At 3,000 feet Bill opened the door, instructing us to look carefully at the scenery below. "See that?" he yelled, pointing to a distant speck. "That's the target."

"O.k.," we nodded, not at all sure that it was o.k. From this height the airport was little more than a few twinkling lights sur-

rounded by a brown and green patchwork of fields. Rows of headlights on the long black ribbon of Highway 21 showed us that we would have to jump soon before it was completely dark.

We had talked for weeks about how nervous we'd be at this moment. We waited for our hearts to pound and our stomachs to jitterbug. We had pictured ourselves hysterically hanging onto the door of the plane screaming "No way! I want to live!" at the last moment.

We morbidly had talked about the Pulitzer Prize winning story one of us would have if the other didn't make it or loused up really bad. But none of that happened. Well, almost. We both jumped and made it safely to the

ground. Our experiences were different, but in discussing them later we discovered that they had several things in common.

In fact, if you promise not to tell our jumpmasters — because they'll never let us jump again — we'll let you in on some secrets that even Chinese water torture couldn't make us divulge.

We're only doing this because we're professional journalists committed to truth in print.

We talked aloud to ourselves all the way down.

We had trouble finding the toggles that steer the chutes.

We had problems steering the chutes.

We both made life-threatening mistakes.

One of us couldn't wait to drop away from the plane and stepped out while she was dangerously close to the platform covering the tire. Her chute could have opened and tangled around it or the impact could have caused the chute to malfunction.

One of us, seeing herself coming down on a pond, steered clear of it only to find herself almost landing on the airplanes parked at the edge of the target field.

One of us nearly overshot the landing field, touching ground halfway between the airport runway and a string of power lines.

If that sounds bad, listen to this. We were warned repeatedly

to check the chute as soon as we felt "opening shock," the sharp, upward jerk of the parachute as it opens. The chute must be checked immediately, so that in the event of a bad chute, plenty of time is left to pull the reserve chute.

And we had seen one of our classmates — who had jumped once and was sitting in on our class as a refresher — kicked out of training and prohibited from jumping for forgetting to do this during a drill.

Well ... we forgot too ... except it wasn't during training. We could have died. Instead we're both going back for our second jumps. We guess God really does protect the ignorant.
