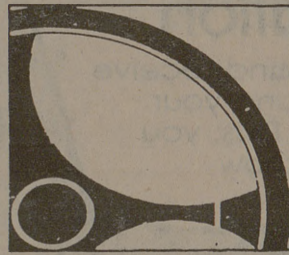

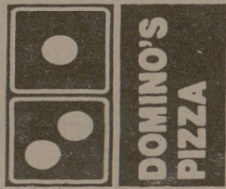

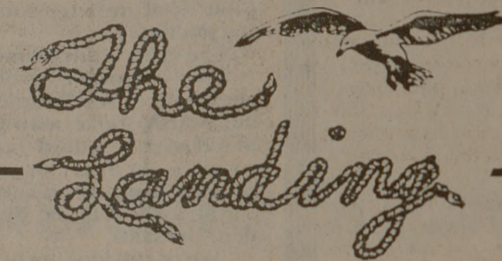

# 'Vigilante' changes lawyers

**NEW YORK** — Confessed slayer "Death Wish" gunman Barry Goetz replaced his court-appointed lawyer Monday with other attorneys, including one who has twice been mugged.

The change in defense lawyers came two days before Goetz is scheduled to be arraigned on charges shot and seriously wounded five teenagers who asked him for \$500 downtown subway train Dec. 22.

Frank Brenner, Goetz's former lawyer, said he resigned because of differences with his client over how to handle the case but would not understand his feelings.

"My decision is based entirely upon a basic irreconcilable disagreement we have concerning his defense to the charges should be conducted," Brenner said. "In the course of our brief association I have come to like him as a person and increasingly to sympathize with his present ordeal."

Attorneys Joseph Kelner and Barry Slotnick have taken over the case.

Allan Horwitz, a friend of Goetz, said the confessed gunman told he switched lawyers because Kelner had been the chief counsel on the case. He had been mugged twice and could not understand his feelings.

Kelner said he was mugged by men last year in the men's room of his law office. The muggers took money and beat him unconscious, he said. Kelner also was mugged at gunpoint in the driveway of his Long Island home.

Slotnick is a criminal lawyer who has defended Mafia suspects in the past.

Goetz has been dubbed the "slayer vigilante" or "Death Wish" gunman after a Charles Bronson movie of that name.

"He's a very soft-spoken, gentle individual who was unfortunately put in a bad position and he had to defend himself and he did," Slotnick said. "Obviously he's unhappy that individuals, those that attacked him, were injured."

"He doesn't want celebrity status. He's not interested. He doesn't like it. Quite frankly, he's not happy about it."

"Mr. Goetz is not a vigilante," Kelner said. "He never before was arrested or convicted of any crime. The truth and the facts are that he acted reasonably and understandably in a life-threatening situation with money being demanded of him."

Goetz and three of his four alleged victims have refused to testify before a grand jury. The wounded teenagers have about a dozen charges pending against them at the Manhattan district attorney's office. He refused to grant them immunity from prosecution.

One of the shooting victims, Darryl Cabey, 19, remained in a coma and was listed in critical condition at St. Vincent's Hospital, a spokesman said. Cabey's spinal cord was severed by a bullet, leaving him permanently paralyzed from the waist down.

At the time of his surrender in New Hampshire on New Year's Eve, Goetz indicated to police that he was willing to face the charges. New Hampshire officials said Goetz confessed to the shooting and the confession contained elements of premeditation.
