### Daredevil dies from stunt, show may be cancelled

HOUSTON — A promotions company that has put on a stunt show for 19 years may drop the event because of the death of a stuntman who plunged to his death from the roof of the Astrodome, a spokeswoman said Tuesday.

"We are reviewing it over the next 30 to 60 days," spokeswoman Susan Wolf said, referring to bringing an end to the Thrill Show and Destruc-

Karel Soucek, 37, plunged to his death Saturday night. He was inside a padded barrel which was to be dropped from the roof of the Astrodome into a tank filled with water

The barrel struck the rim of the tank, crushing Soucek's chest and abdomen and fracturing his skull, the Harris County medical examin-

er's office said. Soucek died about an hour after an ambulance took him to

Wolf said Soucek was the first performer to be fatally injured in the history of the show. About 40,000 spectators were present.

Soucek, who last summer became the fifth person to survive going over Niagara Falls in a barrel, was to have been paid \$20,000 for this stunt, Wolf said.

Soucek and other performers in the show signed a form releasing Pace from liability in case of acci-

Wolf said Pace screens hundreds of applications from would-be daredevils, selecting only those with established professional backgrounds. But, she said, the nature of the stunts are left up to the performers.

### Information denied on corporate merge

NEW ORLEANS - A U.S. appeals court agreed this week with a lower court ruling that the state of Texas can't see confidential premerger information filed with the Federal Trade Commission by Chev-ron Corporation and Gulf Corpora-

The 5th U.S. Circuit Court of Appeals said laws were passed specifically to prevent just what the state of Texas has in mind — using the secret information to block the Chev-

ron-Gulf merger.

Claiming the papers were needed to assure state law was being followed, Texas Attorney General Jim Mattox sought the information after Chevron and Gulf filed premerger information with the FTC in March, 1084

After denying requests by Texas and other states, the FTC subsequently entered into a consent agreement with Chevron and Gulf, subject to final approval, the 5th Circuit said Monday in reviewing the

earlier developments.

The similar lawsuits were filed by

the states of Connecticut, Minnesota, Pennsylvania and Rhode Island after they, too, were denied by the

The 5th Circuit got into the case when Texas appealed the U.S. District Court for West Texas' refusal of the state's request for the FTC infor-

It claimed the 1976 Hart-Scott-Rodino (HSR) Act and FTC regulations governing such mergers did not mean to deprive states of confidential information, so long as state attorneys general agreed to keep it

The 5th Circuit disagreed.

"Precisely the opposite tack is taken by HSR, which does not authorize the FTC to make public any information," said the appeals court's 3-0 decision.


"Rather, it exempts all informa-tion submitted to the FTC and the Justice Department from disclosure under the Freedom of Information Act and requires that no such information or material be made public with two stated exceptions for Congress and its committees.


