Lately I see people on the street, a lot of people, who are playing with ambiguity. On this campus it plays with people's minds. On this campus there's a tendency to react violently to things against the norm."

Lee thinks this is because A&M is so conservative.

"We're associated with being radicals," she says. "I'm also a liberal democrat which is the same thing around here. But as you get older you traditionally become more conservative. But if you start out as neo-Nazis, what then?"

Ann doesn't think androgyny is political or even radical.

"For me, it lies less in the clothes and the lifestyle," she

says. "I'm highly masculine and highly feminine. They are on two discrete scales. My parents never told me that girls act a certain way so I didn't."

Ann says she has always felt she was androgynous in that she is aggressive and competitive, both traditionally thought of as masculine traits.

"But I remember from a very early age my mother saying 'Don't defer,'" she says.

She says everyone is androgynous to a point. She says studies have been done which show people who are more androgynous are happier with themselves. But still, people are uncomfortable with the concept.

"I don't know whether it's the idea of bisexuality or assex-

uality that bothers people," she says. "I really think androgyny has nothing to do with your sexual orientation but more to do with your mental attitude."

But more than anything, the avant-garde people here just want to be free to dress how they like without people harassing them or thinking they are weird.

"For some reason people think we're blind and deaf," she says. "They talk in loud voices and point. They don't seem to realize we're people with feelings, not weirdos."

"If you're rich and you dress weird or you're intelligent and dress weird, you're eccentric. But if you're poor and you dress weird, you're just crazy." **A**
