dancing.


In addition, fair goers competed in more civilized rivalry such as seedspitting and jalepeno-eating contests, and Bevo-calling and Wrangler jean competitions.

The Debonaires, winners of the 1984 Wrangler Country Showdown, played country and rock 'n' roll favorites for a crowded dance floor of county revellers.


