Retail executive

A firm handshake and good eye contact are essential during a job in-terview and can land a graduate's first job, a retail executive said during the Retailing Career Fair Symposium Monday.

"Every company recruiter has their own style," said Rick Ruzza, Neiman-Marcus' coordinator for executive recruitment. "But they all look for a person who has a firm handshake and a confident demean-

The recruiters at Neiman-Marcus headquarters in downtown Dallas interview 800 to 1,000 applicants every graduation season, he said.

"Only 22 of these applicants are finally chosen," Ruzza said. "Unformany outstanding people because of

the limited positions available."

A humble attitude, good posture and leadership skills are traits which set a person apart from their competitors during an interview, Ruzza

Ruzza said the recruiters for Neiman-Marcus start the interview with five minutes of casual conversation about the applicant's hometown or

interests to put the applicant at ease.
"We inform the person what to expect in the next half hour of the interview," he said. "This is when we

discover why the person is interested in Neiman-Marcus and in retailing. "I cringe when I hear the excuse 'I want to be a buyer because I love

traveling' or 'I really love to shop."

He said students should avoid saying "I love working with people" unshould not stray away from the sub-
