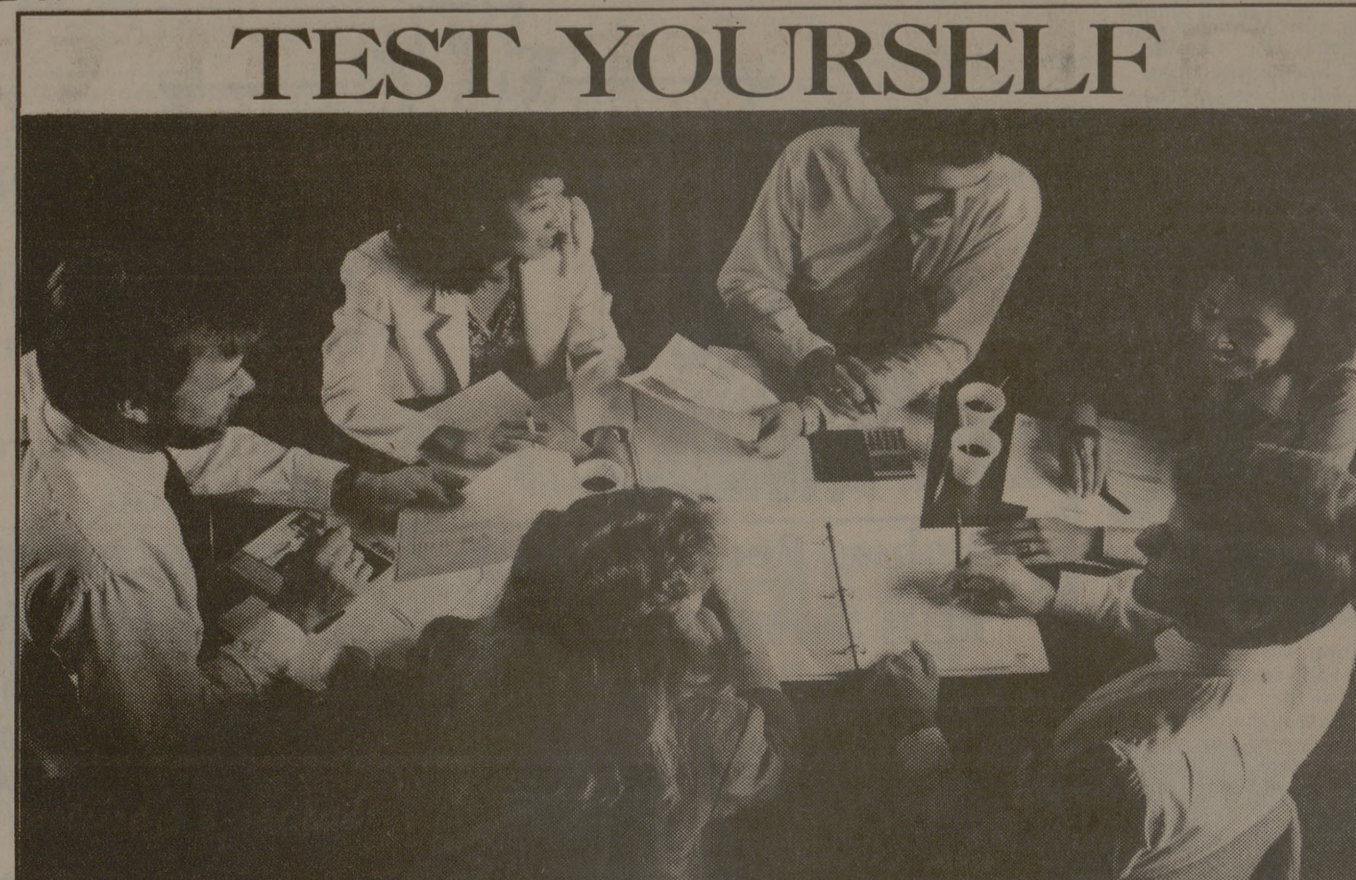

Police persist in hunt for gun used in killings

HOUSTON — Houston police investigating last week's slayings of four members of the same family were continuing their hunt Tuesday for the weapon used in the killings.

Reginald Lewis, 20, was held in police custody all weekend for questioning about the slayings of his father, mother and two brothers in their southwest Houston home. He was released Monday.

Lewis was taken into custody Friday and police obtained permission from a judge to detain him without charges until late Monday morning.

Early Friday, Lewis discovered the bodies of his father, Henry Lewis Sr., 42; his mother, Mary, 42; and brothers Henry Jr., 22, and Byron, 13. The father had been shot, strangled and his body was set on fire, police said. The other three victims were shot at close range.

Homicide investigator Gil Schell Tuesday said detectives still were trying to determine what caliber weapon was used in the slayings.

Lt. H.W. Kersten, head of a team of detectives investigating the slayings, said detectives armed with search warrant again went through the Lewis home on Monday hoping to find the murder weapon.
