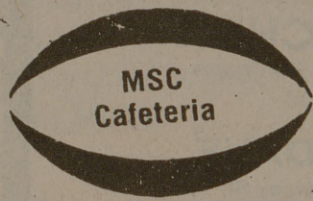

## Crime Stoppers

VICTORIA — Just who is the man who calls himself "Kenneth Earl Barnard?"

Texas law enforcement authorities would sure like to know. They want him for bank robberies in Victoria and Corpus Christi. "Barnard" is also wanted by police in Utah and California for other savings and loan robberies.

Here are a few things investigators know about the suspect:

- He uses a number of aliases. He has an Arkansas driver's license issued in the name of Kenneth Earl Barnard. However investigators have discovered Kenneth Earl Barnard was the name of an infant who died in 1941. Other aliases used by the suspect include John Roger Canoyerr, Edward R. Bright, Edward Grant, and William Grant Osborn.

- The suspect is in his early 40s, is a white male, five to six feet tall, 180 to 200 pounds, has short sandy blond hair, blue eyes, and has a small facial blemish above the upper lip on the right side.

- He is an avid bridge player and compulsive gambler and travels extensively in the southwest and western states.

Investigators from the Corpus Christi Police Department and the Texas Rangers say "Barnard" robbed the First Texas Savings Asso-

ciation in Corpus Christi on Feb. 8, 1984, at about 12:30 p.m.

Then on Fri., March 3, 1984, the same suspect allegedly robbed the Goliad Savings and Loan in Victoria at about 2 p.m. Witnesses say the offender entered the Savings and Loan armed with a blue steel handgun, possibly an automatic. At least \$100 worth of marked money was taken in the robbery, all in \$20 denominations. The vehicle used in the robbery was rented from a Ford dealership in Victoria. Apparently

the suspect switched vehicles after the robbery and was last seen driving a Honda motorcycle with Arkansas plates.

Investigators say "Barnard" also was involved in a Dec. 28, 1983, armed robbery of Presidential Savings and Loan in Salt Lake City, Utah, and the Feb. 4, 1982, robbery of Gibraltar Savings and Loan in Sacramento, Calif. In both of the robberies, he used the alias "William Grant Osborn."

The two Texas robberies landed "Barnard" on this week's Texas Most Wanted list. Armed with information about the identity of the fugitive and where he might be located is asked to call Texas Crime Stoppers toll-free at 800-252-8477 or their local Crime Stoppers program.

All callers may remain anonymous. A \$1,000 cash reward will be paid for information leading to a fugitive's capture.

Texas Most Wanted is a cooperative effort between Crime Stoppers and the Department of Public Safety and is designed to enlist the support of citizens in capturing dangerous fugitives.

## House wants battleship port here nuclear waste dump elsewhere

AUSTIN — The state House voted Wednesday to ask federal officials to put a Navy battleship port in Texas and put the nation's nuclear waste elsewhere.

Also Wednesday, House members voted to invite Vice President George Bush to speak to a joint session of the Legislature on Feb. 27.

The three motions — quickly approved on voice votes — made for one of the longest sessions so far this year in the House, about 20 minutes.

Rep. John Willy, R-Angelton, asked all House members to support the six Texas coastal cities that want

to be home to a battleship. A total of 16 cities from Florida to Texas are seeking the new Navy port. The resolution, already approved in the Senate, got voice vote approval in the House.

Rep. David Hudson, D-Tyler, won approval for his resolution asking the U.S. Department of Energy to forget about putting the nation's high-level nuclear waste dump in Deaf Smith County. A site in the Panhandle county — about 30 miles from Amarillo — is among three finalists. The other sites are in Nevada and Washington state.

Hudson's resolution echoes the

fears of area residents who are concerned about the region's water supply. He told the House the dump could endanger the Ogallala and Santa Rosa aquifers, the main sources of water in the area.

Hudson asked House members to pay closer attention to the resolution than they usually do for such motions.

"This isn't for the basketball team or the Boy Scouts," he said of his resolution.

U.S. Sen. Lloyd Bentsen, D-Texas, has scheduled a Monday public hearing in Hereford concerning the nuclear waste dump.

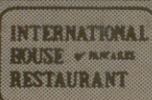
