'Trolls'

Bridges, tunnels, drainpipes shelters to Houston's homeless

HOUSTON — About 75 men inhabit a crude underground world beneath Houston's glistening skyline, huddled under bridges, in tents and tunnels and open drainpipes.

Some people call them "tramps" and "bums." Police call them "trolls." Ted Martin, 21, a former construction worker who hitchhiked to Houston from Illinois two months ago, shares his residence with several other men.

They've fixed up the place with an

abandoned, overstuffed chair, a mattress made of plywood and a make-shift kitchen.

They also have a clothesline for their laundry and an open drain to shower.

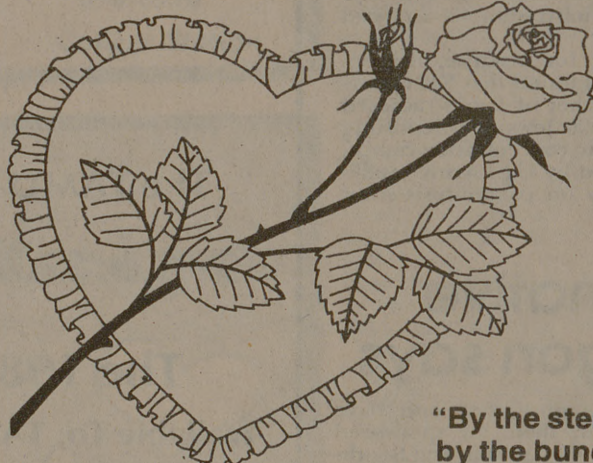
Drinking water is kept in old beer bottles and the men hide their few valuables in make-shift safes.

"We got all the necessities we need," Martin said. "Right here is peaceful. We're partners here. If I'm out of something and he's got it, we share. If I have it and he doesn't, we share. That's the way it goes."
