

Regent's gift creates \$1 million endowment

A \$1 million endowed chair in engineering has been created at Texas A&M University through a gift from Royce E. Wisenbaker of Tyler, a member of The Texas A&M University Board of Regents.

Announcement of the gift from Wisenbaker, a 1939 A&M graduate, was made by University President Frank E. Vandiver Thursday during a committee meeting of the Board of Regents. Wisenbaker has served on

the board for six years.
"This chair exemplifies Mr. Wisenbaker's marvelous generosity to the University that he loves, and our debt to him continues to grow," Van-

Wisenbaker's \$500,000 gift is being matched by the University under the Endowed Faculty Scholars Program authorized by the Texas Legislature during its last session to allow A&M to use Available University Fund money to attract and retain pre-eminent faculty members.

The Wisenbaker chair is being established within the College of Engineering, but the precise area has not been determined. Wisenbaker said he wants to be supportive of

needs expressed by the new dean of engineering, Dr. Herbert Richard-son. He added, however, he hopes the new faculty position will in some manner provide assistance to persons forming and operating small

Wisenbaker, an independent oil and gas producer, said the gift is a "continuation of my interest in

"Texas A&M has done a lot for me, and I want to try to pay it back in some small way," he said, "but there

is no way I can fully pay it back."

The chair is the latest in a series of major gifts from Wisenbaker. He provided the first \$25,000 endowment to establish the program — the President's Endowed Scholarship Program — that has been the major factor in making Texas A&M a leader in enrollment of National Merit Scholars.

Wisenbaker also has a long history of service on behalf of his alma mater. In addition to being a regent, he is a past president of both the Association of Former Students, the University's 130,000-member alumni group, and of The Aggie Club, the University's support organization for student athletes.

Man shoots two teachers

TEMPLE — A man caught going through purses in a teachers' office shot two Temple Junior College in-structors Thursday and held one hostage for 21/2 hours before shooting himself in the chest, authorities

The man, holed up in the Fine Arts Building, was talking with officials on the telephone moments before officers outside heard a single shot, police Sgt. Steve Klempa said. "An officer entered and found the suspect slumped on the floor, passed out," Klempa said. His identity was not released.

Speech teacher Debbie Foster, 30, of Little River, Texas, was shot once in the hip about 3-p.m. and was in good condition at Scott & White Hospital, hospital spokeswoman Carol Trono said.

A management teacher, Laurlyn Carlisle, who Klempa said was shot twice in the leg and hip area, was taken hostage, said Marvin Felder, the school's president.
