56 paintings with stylistically little in common. That comprises the Houston Museum of Fine Art's exhibit entitled Fresh Paint: The Houston School. The exhibit will be on view through April 7 in the Museum's Cullinan Hall and Andrews Gallery. Presented in the exhibition are 44 artists "whose personal visions and independent styles have been significantly influenced by living and working in Houston."

Centrifugal Orbit by Dorothy Hood was painted in 1984. An oil on canvas, it is 10 feet wide and 8 feet tall. Sharon Kopriva painted in 1983. It measures 8 feet, 2 inches wide and 6 feet tall and is mixed media on canvas. La Creacion was painted in 1984 by Luis Fernando Garza. Painted with enamel and oil on masonite, it is 4 feet wide and 5 feet, 6 inches tall. Made of mixed media on terry cloth, Alien Baby consists of four panels (one shown). Each panel is 1 foot square and they were painted in 1984 by James Bettison.
