## Soviets: 'Star Wars' may cause build-up

Tass also quoted Andrei Koko-shin, deputy director of a think tank called the U.S.A.-Canada Institute, as saying international scientists fear a new arms race will begin if the United States develops space weap-

'The other (Soviet) side, scientists believe, will take steps to further develop its strategic systems which guarantee it the possibility of hitting a retaliatory strike," he said."



"It (the system) must be cheap enough to add additional defensive capability so that the other side has no incentive to add additional offensive capability to overcome the de-fense," Nitze said.

Nitze, formerly one of the administration's nuclear arms negotiators, also said that the so-called Star Wars system would have to be proven survivable before it is deployed. Nitze said flatly that "if the new

technologies cannot meet these standards, we are not about to deploy them. In that event, we would have to continue to base deterrence on the ultimate threat of nuclear retaliation

Though the administration hasn't said precisely when the research phase of the Strategic Defense Initiative may end, it is expected to last into the next decade — with a deci-sion on deployment coming perhaps around 1993. 
