Rep. Smith to address budget cuts, students

State Representative Richard Smith will discuss the state budget cuts and their potential effect on college students today at 6:30 p.m. in 601 Rudder.

Smith also will discuss the possibilities of financial aid for students in need. MSC Political Forum is sponsoring the program.

Two tuition bills are now being considered by the House Higher Education Committee and each has a different plan for raising the tuition.

Currently at Texas A&M, in-state students pay \$4 per semester hour and out-of-state students pay \$40 per semester hour.

Bob Piwonka, a Fiscal Department official, said tuition for Texas schools has not been raised since 1971. Texas schools also charge less for tuition than most universities in other states.

The speech is free and is open to all who are interested. A reception will follow the speech and questions will be answered by Smith.
