## Aggie science fiction festival begins today

The Memorial Student Center will be the galactic rendezvous for science fiction fans as AggieCon XVI begins today.

AggieCon XVI, MSC Cepheid Variable's four-day science fiction convention, will be a conglomeration of sci-fi movies, panel discussions, art shows and demonstrations, said Martha Wells, program book editor.

Student passes are available for all of the events scheduled during the convention. For Texas A&M students, a four-day pass to AggieCon XVI is \$7.50 and a one-day pass is \$4. Non-student passes cost \$12 for all four days and \$5 for one day.

Thursday's lineup of night movies are "Rollerball" and Stanley Kubrick's "A Clockwork Orange." Friday night AggieCon will sponsor "The Terminator," "The Adventures of Buckaroo Banzai" and "Phantasm." Saturday night's features are "Star Wars," "The Empire Strikes Back" and "Laserblast."

Other movies and television episodes will be shown from 10 a.m. to 7 p.m. every day on the second floor of the MSC. All the night movies will be in Rudder Auditorium.

Although the movies are what attract many people to AggieCon, Wells said there is much more to see and do than just watch films.

Science fiction writers and illustrators will be on hand for demonstrations, autograph sessions, special readings and panel discussions.

"AggieCon gives students a chance to hear their favorite science fiction writers speak and read their own works," she said.

Wells said panel discussions dealing with science fiction issues will include the topics of "The Trouble with Selling SF is..." "Reagan's Star Wars" and "SF in Rock Videos."

Among the writers and artists to be featured are award-winning science fiction writers John Varley, E. Bryant and artist James Christensen.

Varley will be AggieCon XVI's guest of honor. He has won two Hugo awards and a Nebula award. His awards are given for excellence in science fiction writing. Varley is best known by science fiction readers for his "Titan" trilogy.

Bryant will serve as toastmaster for Saturday's banquet. Bryant, a free-lance writer for 17 years, has won two Nebula awards for the short stories "Stone" and "Giants."

Christensen's artwork has appeared on various book covers and in NASA's 25th Anniversary Show, "Visions of Other Worlds." He currently is working on the Time-Life Books series "The Enchanted World."

Besides the movies and discussions, the dealer's room is another popular part of AggieCon, Wells said. In the dealer's room science fiction-related books, games, posters and other paraphernalia can be purchased.

AggieCon has been a yearly event since 1974, although four conventions before 1974 weren't called AggieCon at that time.
