

# Gorbachev halts nuclear deployment

MOSCOW — Gorbachev said he would hail Gorbachev's decision with President Reagan, and ordered a halt until the end of the year to Soviet nuclear deployment in Europe. 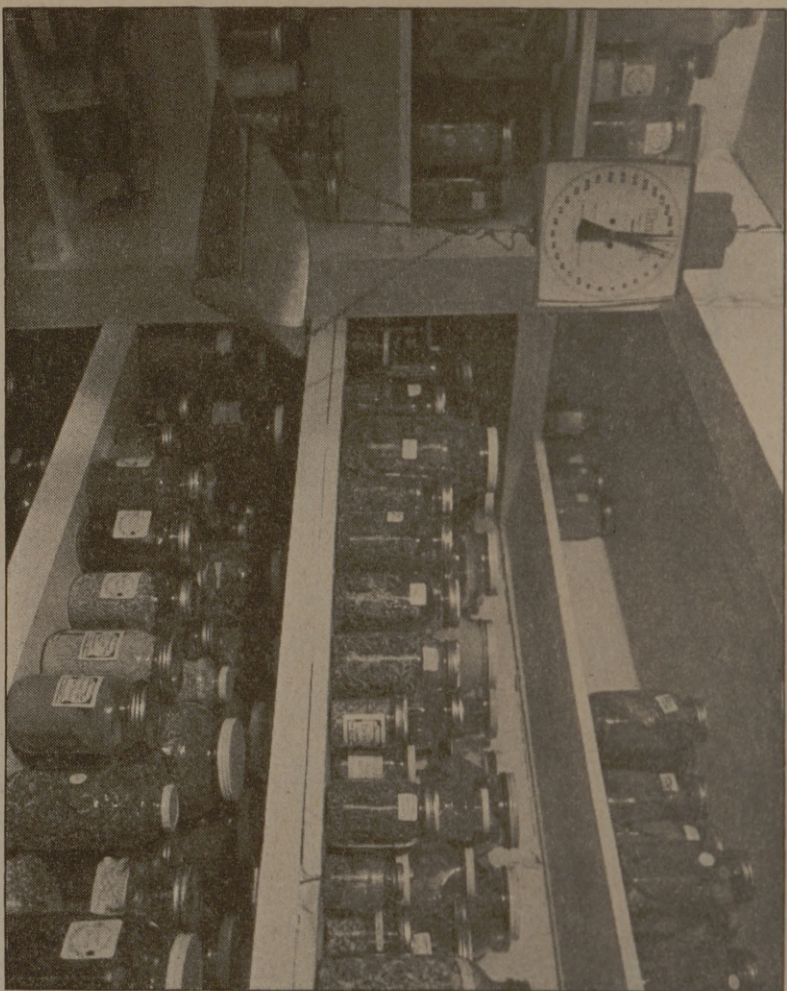
Tass quoted Gorbachev as making the statement in an interview with the newspaper Pravda, when the interview was first broadcast or indicate a publication.

In Santa Barbara, California, Reagan is vacationing. A spokesman for Reagan said they want a firm decision, "not a flimsy one."

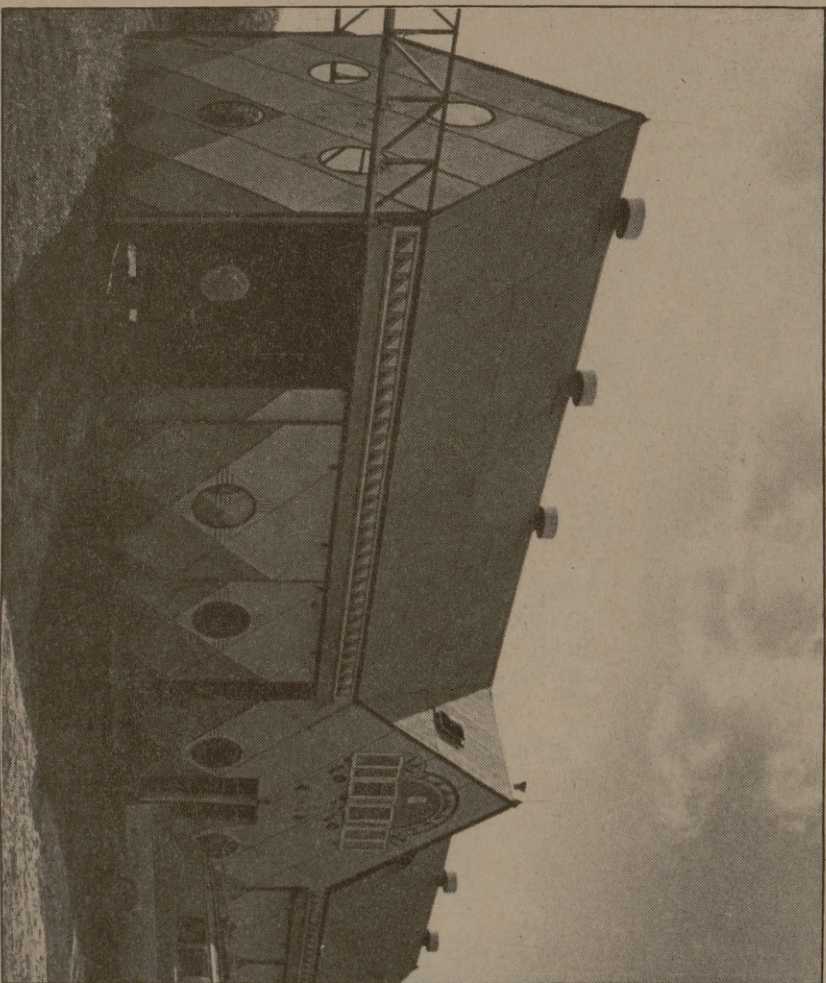
Speakes said Gorbachev is already ready has a 10-15 percent reduction in Europe and that would not affect the balance of power in the United States.
