Ex-politician taking longway home to Texas

WASHINGTON - Alan Steelman can truthfully say, with tongue in cheek perhaps, that he has gone farther than any other former Texas congressman.

His new home is a far cry from Mesquite, from which he rep-resented East Dallas in Congress from 1973 to 1977. But after leaving politics in 1977 and spending a few years in the Washington area, he packed his family up last year and

moved to Singapore.

"The island is 25 miles by 14 miles but there are 2½ million people on the island, so there is not much room for single-family housing," Steelman said in a telephone interview from Singapore. "We live in a high-rise.

Steelman, 43, left politics after running unsuccessfully on the Republican ticket against incumbent Democratic U.S. Sen. Lloyd Bentsen

He stayed in the Washington area, renovating a seven-bedroom, 150-year-old house on the Chesapeake Bay, and then joined the Alexander Proudfoot Co. about seven years ago as a board member. He later became a full-time employee, working as a productivity consultant for the international business consulting firm.

Steelman, his wife, Carolyn, and the three youngest of their five children moved to Singapore when he was named managing director of Alexander Proudfoot Co., Far East.

For Steelman, who "had never been west of Hawaii," the transition from back-slapping good ol' boys in Texas politics to the somewhat ar-cane world of Oriental business required a re-education.

He said he plans to stay in the Far East for another three or four years,

'A lot of people think we are entering an age where the Pacific — that is the United States on one side of the Pacific and the Asian countries on the other — are really going to dominate the world from an economic standpoint the same way the Atlantic had for 300 years," Steel-

After Singapore, Steelman plans to move back to Dallas but remain with the company. No return to politics is currently in the cards, he said.

America's age begins to show

WASHINGTON — The nation's ledian age has topped 31, with the niddle-aged and the very old bemedian age has topped 31, with the middle-aged and the very old becoming the fastest growing segments of society, the Census Bureau reported Wednesday.

The nation's median age was estimated at 31.2 years as of last July 1, meaning that half of all Americans were older than that and half

younger.
"The median age has increased each year since 1971, when it was 27.9 years," the bureau said in a study. "This aging trend is expected to continue as the early baby boom generations head toward middle age."

That aging of the huge post-war baby boom generation, and improvements in medical care extending the typical lifetime, have com-bined to make the middle-aged and very old the fastest growing seg-

ments of the population.

While 'the nation's population grew 4.2 percent between 1980 and 1984, the 35-44 age group increased a huge 19.5 percent. The number of Americans aged 85 and over was close behind with a 19.4 percent in-

"Both of these age groups will continue to grow for some time," the bureau said.
