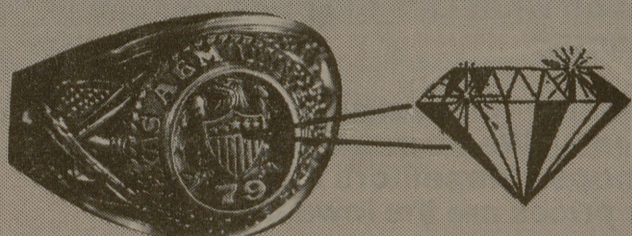

"Gigi," the musical fairy tale, lovely, rebellious 16-year-old who is groomed by her grandmother and aunt for the secure, affluent life of a Parisian coquette, will be performed at 8 p.m. in Rudder Auditorium.

Sponsored by MSC Town Hall Broadway, the play features veteran actors Betsy Palmer, Jaina Elg and Tom Hewitt as Gaston, a playboy who falls in love with her.

The play also stars Canadian actress Lisa Howard in the role of Gigi's grandmother, and Tom Hewitt as Gaston, a playboy who falls in love with her.

Twenty-six years after playing Gaston in the movie version, Howard stars in the stage version as Howard's film by Maurice Chevalier.

Set in Paris at the turn of the century, "Gigi" features such Broadway hits as "Thank Heaven for Little Girls," "I Remember It Well" and "The Night They Invented Champagne."

Based on a novel by the French author Colette, the play tells the story of a young girl trained from childhood to catch a man, but not for marriage.

Her grandmother and aunt, who have gone to great pains preparing Gigi to be a courtesan, are caught guard when they realize Gigi will settle for nothing less than marriage to a wealthy man.

"Gigi" is the last production of MSC Town Hall Broadway season. Jim Hurd, MSC Town Hall staff, will be presenting the following plays in October:

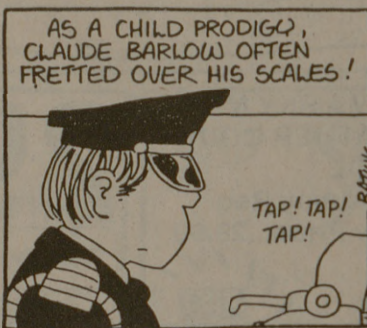

Crocker Hall co-sponsoring 5K run for Village of Hope

Crocker Hall and the Bud Lite Corp. will sponsor a 5K fun run Saturday to benefit the Village of Hope.

Dan Kaulfuf, president of Crocker Hall, says the 3.1 mile run is part of a campaign to aid needy children in Central and South America. Kaulfuf said his dorm has adopted two children in the Colombian village of Bogota, and the money raised from Saturday's event will be used to help them with their day-to-day needs.

"We're providing funds to help

them get on their feet," Kaulfuf said.

The Village of Hope is an organization designed to give people an alternative to regular welfare channels, Kaulfuf said. He also said that the Village of Hope is not just another charity, but that the primary emphasis is on helping people return to normal daily routines. Kaulfuf said that a benefit run through the Texas A&M campus would create more awareness and generate more interest than simply donating money straight from the dorm treasury.

The Bud Lite Corp., co-sponsoring the run, will donate T-shirts and painters caps to partici-

pants on a first-come, first-serve basis.

Registration will begin at 9 a.m. Saturday in front of G. Rollie White Coliseum and will last until the 10:30 a.m. start of the race. The entry fee is \$5 per person. Trophies will be awarded to the first, second and third place winners.

Kaulfuf said he is optimistic about Saturday's event and is hoping that people will turn out and have a good time.

"We're looking for about 100 runners," Kaulfuf said. "We hope it'll raise a lot of money and get a lot of publicity."
