Pan Am leaving Intercontinental, moving to Hobby

Until last month, the New York-based airline operated a 175-person reservation center plus a divisional office

But spokesman Mike Clark said Wednesday the communications equipment has been removed, 111 people have been transferred to Miami and the others have been laid each day.

The airline will be resuming serv-ice out of Houston on April 28, but will work out of Hobby Airport and require far fewer workers, officials

Clark said of the 433 Pan Am employees in Houston before a recent strike by the Transport Workers Union, all that remains is an 11-per-son marketing office and eight man-

Before the 27-day strike by mechanics and ground transportation workers began Feb. 28, Pan Am had 10 flights in and out of Houston
