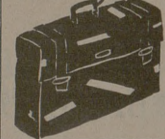

# Legislators discuss proposals to stop premature parole

"In this state it's going to be hard to ask citizens to face an extra rape or murder because the state is in a budget crisis and can't afford to build facilities enough to house its criminals," said Texas Sen. J.E. "Buster" Brown at an Aggie GOP meeting Thursday night.

Brown, from Lake Jackson, and Rep. Dan Morales from San Antonio, are sponsoring a multi-part anti-crime package in the 69th Legislature that deals with, among other things, the early release of prisoners from the Texas Department of Corrections.

Under the current system, inmates are eligible for parole after serving one-third of their sentences. In addition, they can accumulate "good time" that allows them to be considered for parole even earlier. Sometimes so much earlier that they're paroled after serving as little as one-tenth of their assessed sentences.

To stem the flood of inmates released on early parole — a direct result of TDC overcrowding problems — Brown and Morales have proposed a bill that would require all inmates convicted of felony to serve at least one-third of their assessed sentences before being considered for parole.

Brown said there are only two alternatives to prison overcrowding: "We can let prisoners out early and suffer the consequences or provide space for everyone our jurors and judges decide should be jailed."

Other bills in the Brown-Morales anti-crime package include a jury instruction bill that would inform jurors of inmates' parole and good time opportunities before they assess prison sentences; a bill making inmate possession of weapons a third-degree felony; and a bill seeking state financial aid to counties that prosecute inmates who commit crimes while in prison.

Brown said all of these measures are "uncommon solutions with common sense."
