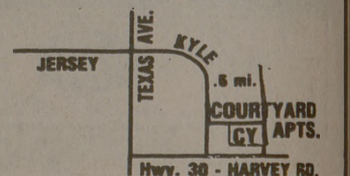

Christian Club needs time to find sponsor

HOUSTON — A high school senior who convinced a federal judge that students should be allowed to hold religious meetings at public schools said Tuesday his first Christian Club meeting was postponed because the group needs a teacher sponsor.

Tony Amidei, a senior at Westchester High School, had planned the group's first meeting on school grounds Tuesday night and expected about 20 students. But he said the meeting was postponed week, so the group could organize. "We've found two teachers who would be willing to act as monitors," Amidei said. "We just have to decide which one we want."

School policy states that every student organization must have a teacher-sponsor, said Mary Kay Galman, spokeswoman for the Spring Branch Independent School District.

Amidei, 18, sued the district a November after administrators denied a request for a club room "to allow a small group of students who have a common interest in Christianity and the life and teachings of Jesus Christ to meet once a week for one hour to discuss common experiences."

Six other students from Westchester and Spring Woods High Schools, both in the Houston area, joined the lawsuit and the U.S. Justice Department intervened in the case.

U.S. District Judge Norman Black last week ordered the two high schools to permit the Christian Club to meet on campus, upholding the controversial Equal Access Act passed by Congress last year.

District Superintendent Henry Wheeler said the school district would comply with Black's order.

"I have no personal feelings about the Christian Club," Wheeler said. "It certainly serves a good purpose, but at the other end of the spectrum we certainly need to keep our separation between church and state."

ined. It's sad to say this, but it's true," Parrish said that if teen-agers are going to have sex, they should be responsible. All these teen-agers said people in their age group need to feel some responsibility. They said adolescence is a transitional stage which is very important in the overall development into adulthood.

These teen-agers were also concerned about the rights of minors in public schools due to the recent suspension of a Bryan High School student, who was distributing literature not approved by school administrators.

"I see school as a foundation where we learn to express our feelings and ideas," Pledger said. "It's defeating the purpose to have all the rules that restrict creativity."

Bass said that public schools are stifling students' creativity, and Parrish, who attended a private school before attending A&M Consolidated, agrees.
