# Slaying

*Infatuated convict charged with killing female guard*

HUNTSVILLE — A Walker County grand jury on Wednesday indicted a murder convict on a capital murder charge in the slaying of a Texas Department of Corrections guard, District Attorney Frank Blazek said.

Ramon Mata Jr., 36, now serving 30 years at the TDC Ellis I Unit for a Pecos County murder, is charged in the death of guard Minnie Houston, Blazek said.

Minnie Houston, 41, was found dead Monday night in a bathroom next to an employee dining room at the Texas Department of Corrections' Ellis I Unit.

Billy Linville, who investigates department matters for the Walker County sheriff's office, said inmate Ramon Mata Jr. admitted to the slaying Tuesday in a six-page statement.

According to his statement, Mata said he killed Houston because he

loved her and "couldn't live without her," Linville said.

"I guess he had some kind of intimate feeling toward her . . .," Linville said. "He's living in a fantasy world."

Houston, a department employee since October 1979, was assigned to supervise a seven-member crew of inmate trustees — which included Mata — at the dining area, prison spokesman Charles Brown said.

Investigators said the guard had been stabbed about 10 times with a 15-inch butcher knife. The knife was found in Houston's car, and Mata's clothes were bloody, officials said.

One of Houston's three sons, Robert Houston, 21, is a guard. Another son, Terrell Houston, 18, said he also plans to become a guard.

"It's the only thing around here with a good income," Terrell Houston said.

Houston was the first prison system employee killed since April 4, 1981.

# Lt. Governor expects naval port decision

AUSTIN — Lt. Gov. Bill Hobby said Wednesday it is his "impression" that Corpus Christi and Pensacola, Fla., are in the final running for a new Navy homeport.

"I think we can expect an announcement any day now," Hobby told the general session of the Texas Good Roads-Transportation Association.

Hobby also said he believed, from his contacts in Washington, that if Congress approves adding a 15th

aircraft carrier to the Navy fleet, it likely would be based with the battleship Wisconsin at the new homeport on the Gulf coast. The 15th carrier has been recommended by President Reagan but not approved by Congress.

"If the 15th carrier is ever added, I think it would be based at the same place with the battleship," Hobby said.

Four other finalists in the homeport competition were announced earlier by the Navy, including the Houston-Galveston area.
