#### Abstract

AUSTIN - Lubbock Monterey and DeSoto, two teams with a tradition of making it to the state baseball tournament, return again this year. Class 5 A Monterey won state championships in 197 , 1974 and 1981, and the Plains 4 A team, won its only baseball title in 1979 but finished second in 1980,1983 and 1984. The Eagles defeated defending champion Austin Westlake and Waco Midway two out of three to advance to the tournament. Other former champions in the tournament are Colmesneil in Class A Riviera in 2A and Linden-Kildare in 3 A . Jasper, a 4 A squad, is making its fift appearance in the tournament but has never won a championship. Eleven of the 20 schools are playing in the tournament for the first time. The state tourney semifinals are on Thursday, starting at 1 p.m. with ter ( $10-8$ ).
