Movie box offices sizzling

Rambo killing opposition

HOLLYWOOD — "Rambo: First Blood Part 2," Sylvester Stallone's Vietnam rescue fantasy, slaughtered its competition at the box office for a fourth week, but "Prizzi's Honor," a love story about hired killers, opened strong in fourth place.

"Rambo" took in \$9.2 million during the weekend at a record 2,074 screens for a total of \$85 million. It is likely to become the first summer release to top \$100 million.

"The Goonies," Steven Spielberg's pirate adventure, was in second place with a weekend gross of \$8.4 million. It has earned \$22 million since opening two weeks ago but may face competition from several

other Spielberg films set for summer release.

"Fletch," a Chevy Chase comedy about an oft-disguised investigative reporter, placed No. 3 in its third week. "Fletch" grossed \$5.2 million for a total of \$24.5 million.

"Prizzi's Honor" opened last week to critical praise. The black comedy directed by John Huston stars Jack Nicholson as a hit man for a mob family who falls in love with Kathleen Turner, portraying an independent contract killer.

The movie drew \$4.2 million at 719 theaters and had the best per-screen-average, \$5,841, of any current release.

Tom Sherak, 20th Century Fox's distribution president, said "Prizzi"

played strongest in urban areas and was weakest in blue-collar markets. However, he said he hoped that word-of-mouth endorsements will build demand for "Prizzi." Fox is considering a tougher advertising campaign to woo more blue-collar moviegoers.

Fifth place went to the James Bond film "A View to a Kill," with a weekend gross of \$3.4 million. "Brewster's Millions" gathered \$2.8 million in sixth. Another new release, "D.A.R.Y.L.," earned \$2.6 million in its first week for seventh place, followed by "Perfect," the newly opened "Secret Admirer" and "Beverly Hills Cop," which held the tenth spot after 28 weeks.

U.S. court rules against Gideons

DES MOINES, Iowa — The Gideons International has agreed to stop handing out Bibles in Iowa public schools as part of a settlement in a federal suit that challenged it under the principle of separation of church and state.

Officials of the Iowa Civil Liberties Union filed suit against the Gideons and the Adel-DeSoto Community School District on behalf of Steven J. Feirstein and his daughter, Jenna. The Gideons had distrib-

uted Bibles to the girl's fifth grade class on May 1, 1984.

The ICLU said it was the first agreement of its kind in the nation involving the Gideons.

ICLU staff counsel Mark Bennett said, "The Gideons now recognize that they exceed their free exercise of religion when they utilize the public schools to assist them in distributing their religious message."

In a consent decree approved Friday by U.S. District Judge Harold Viotor, the Gideons also agreed not

to provide Bibles to public school officials for distribution, while the school district agreed not to distribute Bibles in the future and to establish a section on comparative religion in its school libraries.

The decree cannot restrict the Gideons' ability to distribute Bibles in Iowa on public property other than schools, unless the distribution involves the active assistance of public officials.

Wendell McClinton, assistant to the executive director, said the Gideons had no comment.

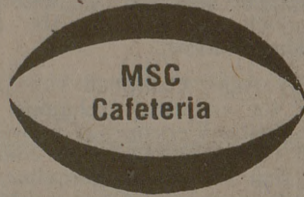

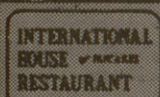

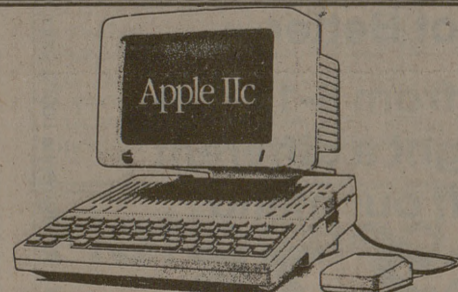
