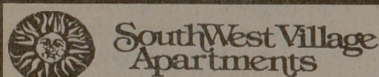

Doctors limit surgery in response to 'inadequate' malpractice laws

ALBANY, N.Y. — Dozens of up-state doctors, angry over what they feel is an inadequate reform of malpractice insurance laws, sharply limited surgery Monday and told malpractice lawyers to "find another pigeon."

The protest over rising insurance rates coincided with the first day of a more-than-50 percent insurance premium hike that was approved by the state Insurance Commissioner. In an eight-county area of western New York, medical officials made provisions to send severe surgical cases to neighboring states and Canada.

In Syracuse, just eight of 40 orthopedic surgeons were operating. At the State University Hospital's Upstate Medical Center there, a coffee shop and a clinic were converted to deal with an anticipated overflow of patients turned away from doctors' offices and private hospitals.

"I warn you, find another pigeon," Dr. Thomas A. Lombardo of the Erie County Medical Society said of malpractice lawyers Sunday in an address to a doctors' meeting in Buffalo. "Your incredible greed has killed the golden goose. The egg is no longer going to be there. You've awakened a sleeping giant."

Some doctors had been slowing down their work over the past two months, leading to layoffs at at least one hospital.

Their protests intensified even after the state Legislature passed a law over the weekend that is designed to stem the rise of malpractice premiums.

The law, which awaits Gov. Mario Cuomo's signature, was deemed inadequate by many in the medical profession.

"In 1961, I paid \$200" in insurance premiums, said Dr. David Dean, a Buffalo cardiologist. "Now, I'm up to \$10,000, and that premium is small compared to a neurosurgeon."

The doctors' loudest complaint centers on their inability to get a \$1 million cap on personal liability and \$250,000 cap on pain and suffering awards.

The New York State Bar Association "is pleased that proposals to cap pain and suffering and create a restrictive form of arbitration" were omitted from the legislation, said bar president Justin L. Vigdor. He called the legislation an "effective antidote, but not a cure-all for the insurance problems plaguing the state's physicians."

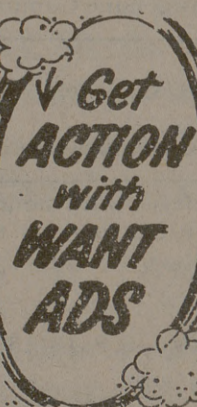
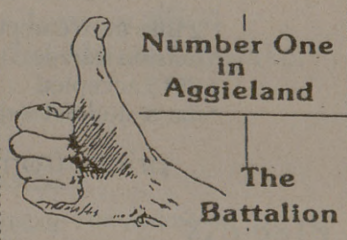
