Austin to restrict use of water

AUSTIN — City residents could be ticketed by police for a misdemea-nor and fined up to \$200 beginning Wednesday for violating mandatory

The restrictions were announced by City Manager Jorge Carrasco on Sunday, after three straight days of water use above the city's 150 million

"The voluntary program that we have been involved in since May 1 will now be required," Carrasco said. "The major effect is that citizens will be asked to water (lawns) once every

Austin, which sits along the Colorado River, has more than adequate water supplies. However, the city's wastewater treatment capacity has failed to keep pace with booming population growth.

Maximum total capacity for the city's three water treatment plants is 165 million gallons daily.

Under city rules, water use restrictions are imposed if water use tops 150 million gallons for three straight days or 157 million gallons on any one day. The city pumped 151.1 million gallons last Thursday, 156.7 million on Friday and 153.35 million on Saturday. on Saturday.

The mandatory conservation program restricts outdoor water use. Lawns may be watered only once every five days — and watering is prohibited between noon and 7 p.m.

The city began voluntary conservation measures on May 1. Lowerthan-normal temperatures and sub-stantial rainfall during June and early July helped delay mandatory

But high temperatures and a lack of rain in recent weeks — the mer-cury reached 98 degrees Saturday and 99 on Sunday — sparked higher water use, officials said.

Cockatoo missing from Dallas Zoo

DALLAS - The way police see it, a rare palm cockatoo missing from the Dallas Zoo had no reason to leave home.

"It was a bird in paradise. It had plenty of food and water and a mate," said park police Sgt. Jimmy Billingsley. "Why would it want to

escape?"

Foul play is what authorities suspect lies behind the weekend disappearance of the \$10,000 bird.

Early Saturday, about 90 minutes before the zoo opened, a bird-keeper found a hole in the wire cage

that held a pair of the rare creatures. Missing was the female half of the couple, a 2-foot-tall, 5-pound bird

Wildlife experts say the breed, an endangered species found only in Australia and New Guinea, is a hot item on the black market.

The cockatoos cannot be legally exported from their native lands and few are in captivity. The Dallas Zoo got two pairs in November 1983 from U.S. Justice Department officials, who seized a cache of contraband birds from smugglers.

Because the palm cockatoo is so rare, zoo officials kept one pair away from public view in hopes of getting them to breed, said Jim Murphy, curator of amphibians and reptiles for the zoo.
