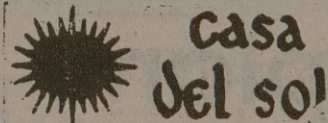

ate, but was vetoed by the governor in July.

David Eisen, research and information director of the Guild in Reston, Va., told The Battalion the VDT bills did not pass because "the manufacturers (of VDTs) have lobbied them to death."

The Guild supports VDT legislation because studies done on VDT operators show VDTs to be a health problem, Eisen said.

States eventually will pass VDT legislation because the issue will remain until VDT regulations are enforced, he said.

George Cashau, technical re-

search director of the American Newspaper Publishers Association, which opposes VDT legislation, said in a telephone interview that VDTs can't be directly linked to any of the problems VDT operators complain of.

"I think VDT legislation will stifle scientific progress," Cashau said.

Cashau said VDTs can't be directly blamed for a poor work environment with little mobility.

He said properly-fitted chairs and adjustable tables are a problem for employers to solve.

VDT operators who want more rest breaks and free eye exams simply want "freebies," he said.

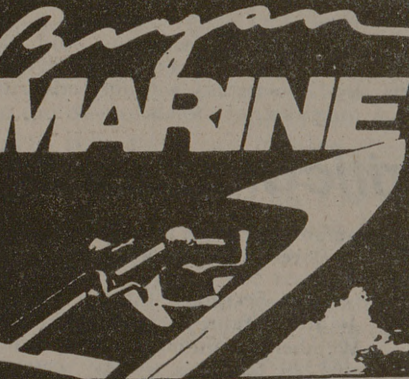
