

Witness in child pornography case wants to remain in safe foster care

BROWNSVILLE — The mother of a teen-age girl being held as a material witness in a pornography case went to court Tuesday in an ef-fort to regain custody of her daugh-

But the 14-year-old girl told State District Judge Menton Murray Jr. that she wanted to stay in foster care until the end of the trials of two accused pornographers.

"I feel it would be more safe if I stayed here in foster care until the trial is over," the girl said.

The girl, a runaway from Missouri, allegedly posed nude for two Brownsville men who have been indicted on charges of inducing sexual performance by a child. performance by a child.

She has been in the Cameron County Juvenile Detention Center since July 10. A \$5,000 bond is

But Assistant District Attorney Gustavo Garza and attorney Gail Kahn, who was appointed as the girl's legal guardian, urged that the girl continue to be held in foster

"She wants to be released, but she doesn't want to go back to Missouri," Kahn said. "Because of the testimony she is going to make she feels she would not be protected. She wants to remain in foster care. I un-derstand her fears."

Kahn was appointed last week as the girl's guardian because the mother had failed to appear for two previous hearings.

Attorney Larry Warner, however, urged that the girl be turned over to her mother, who said she now can

"I love my daughter and I was her with me," the mother told to court. "I think I can keep das enough tabs on her to keep her from running away."

But the woman said she mis the previous hearings because st was told not to be in Brownsville u til Tuesday. She said she already ha enrolled her daughter in a mem health clinic and planned to plan
