

Rumbaugh, 18, executed because of teenage crime

HUNTSVILLE - Charles Rumbaugh was put to death by poison injection early today for murdering a jeweler when he was 17 years old, the first execution in more than two decades for a crime committed by someone under the age of 18.

Rumbaugh, 28, was pronounced dead at 12:27 a.m. CDT, said Jim

Mattox, the state attorney general. Hours before his death, Rumbaugh was "cutting jokes and laughing" as he visited with friends and relatives in a cell a few feet from the death chamber, said corrections department spokeswoman Sarah Gri-

Amnesty International, which opposes capital punishment, had protested Rumbaugh's execution, saying it violated international agreements — never ratified by the U.S. Senate — that bar execution of people convicted of crimes committed when they were under 18.
