**SG is considering changing election filing procedures**

After considerable debate, the Student Senate voted Wednesday night to put an emergency bill on the agenda concerning elections for freshman class officers and senators.

Normally, the opening and closing dates for filing, the filing sites, the dates and sites of the elections, runoffs and candidates' meetings are announced no less than 10 class days prior to the opening date for filing.

However, because classes for the fall semester began a week later than last year, the bill provides that the announcements be made no less than five class days prior to the opening date for filing.

Chris Gavras, election co-commissioner, said the reason for moving up the elections is to get the freshman senators involved sooner.

The bill also increases the candidates' filing fee from \$3 to \$5 "for promotional purposes of the election commission," Gavras said.

The elections for freshman president, vice president, secretary, treasurer, social secretary and eight freshman senators will be Oct. 7 from 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. in two polling places, one on the north and one on the south side of campus, with the specific locations to be named by the election commission.

If necessary, run-off elections for freshman class officers will be Oct. 11 from 8 a.m. to 2 p.m. The eight senate candidates with the most votes will win the election.

In other business, Student Body President Sean Royall addressed the members on the student body's expectations of the Senate.

"I think that your effectiveness is partly dependent on the expectations of others," he said.

"I think that merely knowing your responsibility is not enough. You must meet them too," Royall added.

He challenged the senators to meet their responsibilities to avoid some of the problems that occurred

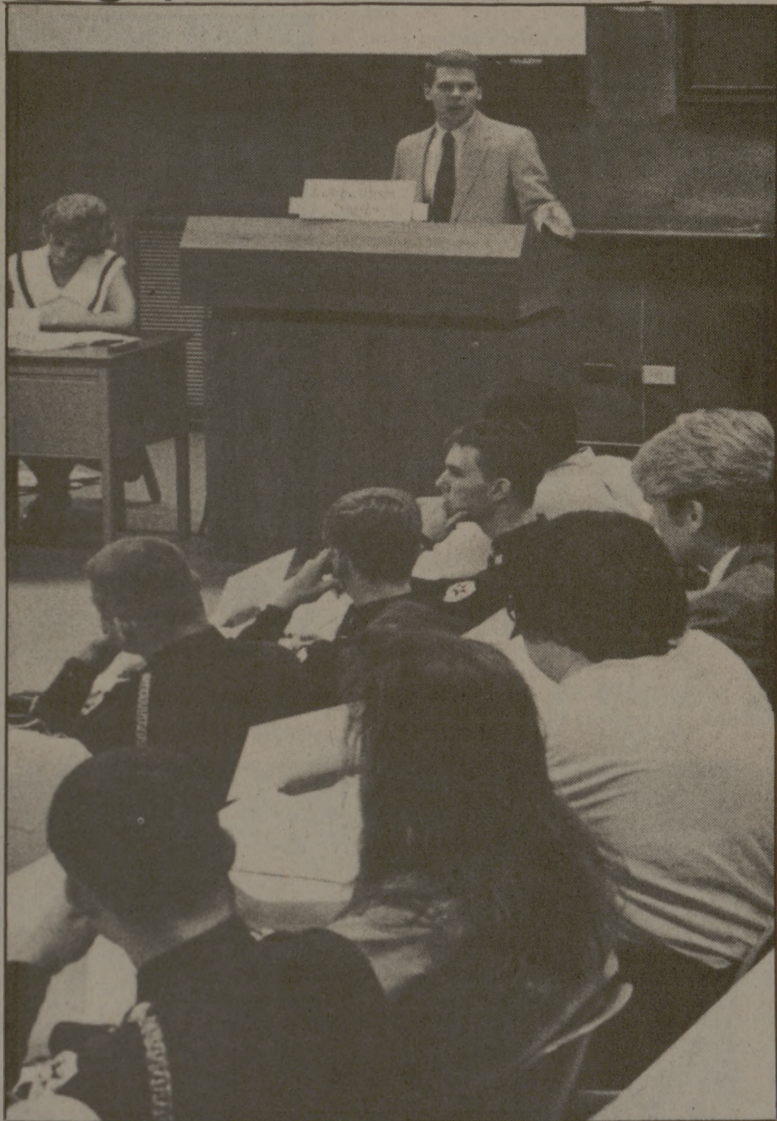

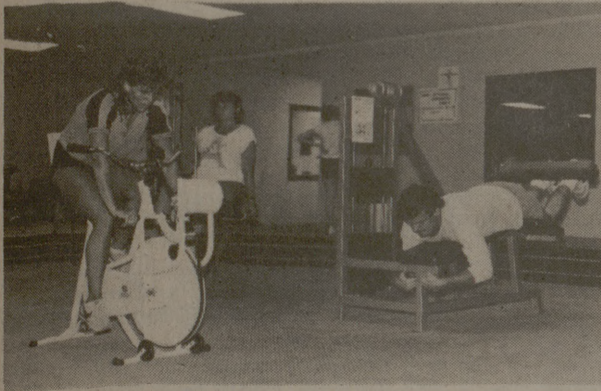


