

In an effort to combat the rising number of vehicle thefts in the area, the College Station Police Department is sponsoring a vehicle identification program, a depart-ment representative said Tuesday.

"If the property is identified, people (thieves) are going to tend to away from it," said Lt. Bernie

Kapella said vehicle owners can

HOUSTON - The owner of Gilley's Club, a country-western night spot made famous by the movie "Urban Cowboy," pleaded innocent Tuesday to charges of attempted murder and aggravated assault. Club owner Sherwood Cryer, 63,

entered his plea before State District Judge Albert Pruett. He is free on \$5,000 bond.






