"This is not a battle cry against the University," Cokinos says. "We want to talk with the administration to see what can be done."

Martine McManus, another member of the group, says she believes the forum was a success.

"By speaking up, we think the administration will realize they need to change this policy," McManus says.

But not everyone thinks the

policy needs to be changed.

John Tate, a senior marketing major, says he doesn't agree with giving the service.

"I don't pay \$15 for you people to have premarital sex — it's not my obligation," Tate says. "Your argument is no greater than mine and you should not dictate how my portion of the \$15 is spent."

Patti Edwards, a married graduate student, countered Tate's argument.

"I'm married," she says, "and I pay my health fees."

"That's because national merit is largely dependent on how well (a student) does on a test (PSAT) as a junior in high school," he added.

In the past, some students who received equivalent scholarships from A&M and another school have asked Cress to raise the amount of money offered, he said.

With these scholarships goes the responsibility of maintaining a 3.0 grade-point ratio. If a student with a Lechner Fellowship or McFadden Scholarship fails to keep that GPR,

Cress said the money left over is channeled through the dean's office to a select group of juniors with a GPR over 3.5.

But if a student loses his Presidential Endowed Scholarship, the funds go back to the endowment, Cress said.
