

#### Union leader says imports rob Texans of 50,000 jobs

AUSTIN — Texas has lost 50,000 production jobs the last five years, both union and non-union, because of imports, Texas AFL-CIO President Harry Hubbard said Monday. We have a full-fledged recession

in Texas at this time and one of the major causes is loss of manufacturing, chemical processing and refin-ing jobs," Hubbard said in a

Hubbard also noted that for the

first time ever the Texas unemploy-ment rate last month was a full per-centage point higher than the na-

tional average.
"One of the primary reasons for the loss of jobs in Texas is imports,' Hubbard said.

Hubbard announced Saturday at a "Buy American" rally in Austin that the Texas AFL-CIO was launching a long-range program to encourage Texans to buy products made in
