## Mattox appoints Hightower as first assistant

AUSTIN — Former U.S. Congressman Jack Hightower, who has considered running again for Congress in 1986, accepted an appointment Tuesday as first assistant attorney general of Texas.

"I have been urged by many good friends and supporters in the 13th Congressional district to run again," Hightower told a news conference after taking the oath of office. "As much as I appreciate their encouragement, I have decided not to do so."

Mattox also appointed special assistant Mary Keller as executive assistant for litigation for the department overseeing all legal activities of the 231 assistant attorneys general.

Mattox said she would be the first woman to hold that position. Keller succeeds Dave Richards, who resigned to return to private practice.

Hightower, a Democrat, was elected to Congress in 1975 but was defeated in the 1984 general election by current U.S. Rep. Beau Boulter, R-Amarillo.

Like Mattox, Hightower graduated from Baylor University Law School. He served in the Texas House in 1953-54 and in the state Senate from 1965 through 1974. He was Wilbarger County district attorney from 1955 through 1961.

Keller has been a special assistant attorney general since 1983.

## Candidate detained for threats

SAN ANTONIO — A congressional candidate accused of threatening to drop boulders on a former employer was ordered held Tuesday until he either pays a \$20,000 cash bond or voluntarily commits himself for psychiatric treatment.

Lowell "Duke" Embs was arrested last week on a federal indictment accusing him of making threatening telephone calls and writing menacing letters to officials of Connecticut Mutual Life Insurance Co.

Embs, 56, is a candidate for the Republican nomination for the 21st congressional seat now held by Rep. Tom Loeffler, R-Hunt.

"There's something bothering this man," said U.S. Magistrate Jamie Boyd, citing Embs' long history of arrests on various charges in the past four years.

"I believe if I released him on bond he'll be back here in 30 days."

Boyd said he would not release Embs on personal recognizance unless he commits himself to a hospital and undergoes treatment.

## Witness to flag raising at Iwo Jima dead

A Texan who said he had the idea to raise a state flag beside the U.S. flag on Iwo Jima is dead.

Funeral services for Andrew Carter, 59, were held Tuesday in Fort Worth.

Carter told the Fort Worth Star-Telegram in 1980, on the 35th anniversary of the Iwo Jima landing in World War II, that he and a friend had the idea to raise the Texas flag when six U.S. Marines raised the U.S. flag.

Carter said his buddy had a flag in his pack.

"We thought about putting it with the American, but we decided against it because the climb up the top was very rugged," Carter said.
