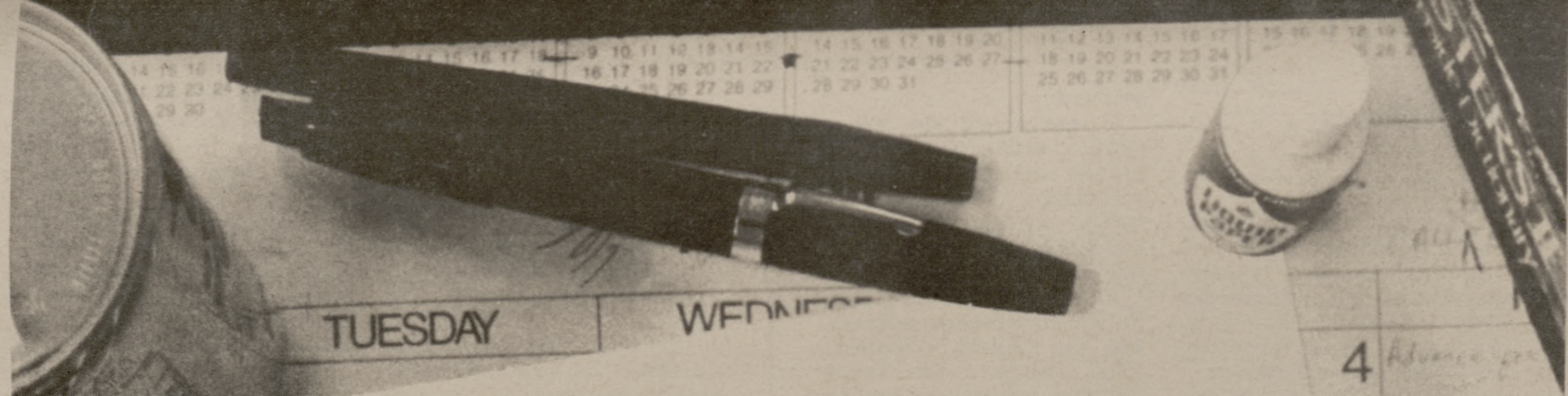


Embellishments create an undercover look at Police Beat
