Forty per cent of Texas A&M's initial allotment of 20,000 tickets to the 1986 Cotton Bowl will go to the members of the Aggie Student Body. Through special arrangements with Texas A&M Athletic Director Jackie Sherrill, A&M students will be given a \$5 (five dollar) discount per ticket on the normal price of \$25 per ticket, representing a savings of \$40,000 for the overall student body. ONE PERSON CAN PURCHASE UP TO A MAXIMUM OF 6 (SIX) TICKETS. THE TICKET PURCHASER MUST HAVE IN HIS OR HER POSSESSION 6 (SIX) TEXAS A&M COUPON BOOKS AND AT LEAST THREE OF THEM MUST BE SENIOR, JUNIOR OR GRADUATE STUDENT COUPON BOOKS.
