

SAN ANTONIO — A legal center to handle family abuse cases has brought lawyers from the Bexar County district attorney's office to-gether with staff members of the Texas Department of Human Resources to help victims, officials say.

The unit was designed to make dealing with the legal system easier for victims of child abuse, prosecu-

The common office will be ready for occupancy by 32 workers in late February. Officials say its spouseabuse component, which has operated since January 1984, has helped more than 3,600 victims.

'When a case comes over from the Police Department or (human services department), it will be assigned to one lawyer and one advocate who will see it through all the way to court," says attorney Karen Amos, legal chief of the unit.

The child will not be shuffled around or have to tell his story constantly," she says. "This is called vertical prosecution; the continuity helps make the child more comfort-

Three child abuse advocates in the office become the lifeline be-tween the victim and the legal sys-tem, officials say. They provide a re-assuring hug, a concerned voice on the phone and patient explanation.

"Most district attorney's offices don't have advocates, but they are needed because the attorneys can't devote that much time to victims,' Joy Hollingsworth, advocate supervisor, says.


