statements to the press that the Micro Center is not a function of the University.

He names Wasson and individuals acting under his authority as members of the public group that operates the Micro Center.

Under the state's fair trade laws, public groups that conspire to damage a competitor's business through unlawful trade practices can be held accountable for damages.

The petition is in a legal hiatus now because a Constable has been unable to serve Wasson the legal papers to begin trial proceedings.

Texas law allows the defendant, Wasson, 20 days after papers are served to consult with an attorney and prepare for the case.

Strangely the two sides are asking to be represented by the same attorney — Attorney General Jim Mattox.

KLS asks that Mattox represent it and cites the Attorney General's function to protect the general business public as its argument. However, the Attorney General is also A&M's attorney in these cases.

Hawtrey says he will argue that allowing the Attorney General to represent A&M would be a greater waste of taxpayer's money.

A spokesperson in the Attorney General's office says a copy of the petition will not be filed with the Attorney General until Wasson is served with the petition.

She did say that it would be highly unlikely that the Attorney General would not represent A&M.

for Apple as a result of the consortium.

"It was a way to find out what the Macintosh could really do by exposing it to people who could stretch its limits," Dixon said.

The 24 schools joining with Apple all are licensed to sell Apple computers directly to their students, faculty and staff, Dixon said.

She said none of the schools maintains a relationship with local Apple dealers.

Dixon said because the consortium program generated a large interest among other universities, Apple developed the UPP in August 1984.

She said the UPP is basically an extension of the consortium program, but universities under the UPP aren't obligated to produce new software for Apple.

or an author, who gets a large burst of income in one year. IRS Publication 506 explains it.

- Be prepared to substantiate any deduction you claim.

- Deduct 12 cents a mile for use of your car, plus tolls and parking, in connection with volunteer work for a charitable organization. If you keep records, deduct oil and gas costs plus tolls and parking. Don't deduct the value of your services to charity.

- Those little numbers under "1985" in the upper right corner of many forms — such as 07 on Schedule A — have a purpose. Attach documents to your return in numerical order. Papers without those numbers should go last.

- You may defer reporting inter-

est on Series E or EE Savings Bonds until the year they mature or cash them, whichever is earlier.

- An employee who claims a deduction for driving a personal car for business will have to answer a new series of questions on Form 2106.

- A worker who uses a car for personal purposes to find the value of that personal property included on the W-2 earnings statement. It's taxable. If W-2 10 includes the car's total value, a worker may deduct any business use on Form 2106. See Publication 2106.

- How strongly do you feel about the government's \$2-trillion deficit? Your donation to reduce it is mailed with your tax return. Check should be made out to the Bureau of the Public Debt. You deduct the contribution when you file your return a year from now.

computers. All of the programs are standardized for the Zenith computers, and an excellent service program is available on campus for computer repair, he said.

Cliff Sjogren, director of admissions for the University of Michigan, said Michigan has dealt with the increasing need for computer access differently than Clarkson and Dartmouth.

"The whole approach here has been to literally flood the campus with terminals so students can access our main frame," Sjogren said.

He said by having accessible computers on campus, Michigan won't

have to require their students to purchase personal computers.

When the program is completed there will be about 1,500 terminals on campus, Sjogren said.

All students are required to pay a \$100 fee each semester for the service, Sjogren said. He said the fee allows students unlimited access to terminals all over the campus.

Sjogren said Michigan has a micro center similar to A&M's, and students can buy computers through the university that are compatible with Michigan's system.

Joe Nowak, student computer consultant for Michigan's Micro Educational Computer Center, said

only full-time students, faculty staff members are eligible to purchase computers through the university.

Nowak said the university includes local dealers in their program.

He said the local dealers offer same prices as the university. Nowak said the university's sale made through the dealers.

Rich Rosell, sales manager in nacomp Computer Systems in Arbor, said the processing fee is nominal and only allows dealers break even on each sale.
