He names Wasson and individuals acting under his authority as members of the public group that operates the Micro Center.

Under the state's fair trade laws, public groups that conspire to damage a competitor's business through unlawful trade practices can be held accountable for damages.

now because a Constable has been unable to serve Wasson the legal papers to begin trial proceedings

Texas law allows the defendant, Wasson, 20 days after papers are served to consult with an attorney and prepare for the case.
