Movie Review

"Pretty in Pink" is just about what one might expect from John Hughes, the creator of "Sixteen Candles" and "The Breakfast Club": a funny, sweet, well-acted, relatively realistic teen comedy-drama. Unfortunately, it's not much more than that.

Hughes, who serves as the film's screenwriter and executive producer, has fashioned a likable little movie that surpasses "Weird Science," his previous effort, by miles, but doesn't quite capture the sense of "real life" which permeated "The Breakfast Club."

"Pretty in Pink" revolves around Andie Walsh (Molly Ringwald), a girl from the wrong side of the tracks who attends a mostly "richie" high school. She passes the time calmly bearing the taunts of her classmates and occasionally moping about her lack of a date to the prom.

The trouble starts for Andie when she falls in love with

Blane (Andrew McCarthy), a nice but wealthy guy who eventually asks her to the prom. His friends don't like his crossing

lesser extent than in past efforts. The film contains a number of funny scenes, and Hughes

social boundaries, and neither do hers.

Most of the movie's insights into the problems of class differences and peer pressure have been covered before, most notably in 1983's "Valley Girl." Yet the dialogue and performances are so fresh and enjoyable that they save "Pretty in Pink" from becoming just another rehash.

Hughes has received high praise for his ability to capture the way real teenagers talk. His success in this area continues in "Pretty in Pink," although to a

degree that makes the most of them. There is hardly a dud in the entire bunch.

In the dramatic scenes, however, he scores less frequently. Too often the script makes the characters sound like "characters" instead of real people. One scene in particular, in which Andie and her father (Harry Dean Stanton) come to grips with her mother's three-year absence, seriously strains the movie's credibility by leaning too heavily in the direction of bathos.

Fortunately, "Pretty in Pink" has a cast of overpowers most of the weaknesses in the script. Molly Ringwald delivers another remarkably natural performance and continues to display the potential to become a major star in the near future. Ditto Andrew McCarthy, who successfully straddles the line between nice guy and jerk.

Yet the scene-stealer in this movie is Jon Cryer as Duckie, Andie's nerdy friend who likes her a lot more than she knows. The character is essentially a better-developed version of the geek from "Sixteen Candles": he's funnier, but also less irritating and more sympathetic. You almost hope that he, not Blane, will end up with Andie on prom night.

Despite its familiarity, "Pretty in Pink" still manages to get the viewer on its side and keep him there. It may not be anything special, but it does entertain. That's more than can be said for a lot of movies.
