AUSTIN — Genene Iones' lawyer asked a state appeals court Wednesday to reverse the conviction that sent the ex-nurse to prison for 99 years in the death of a Kerrville in-

Fifteen-month-old Chelsea Mc-Clellan died Sept. 17, 1982, after suffering mysterious seizures while in the care of Jones, who worked in a Kerrville pediatrician's office.

Tests performed after the tod-dler's body was exhumed showed she had been injected with succinylcholine, a muscle relaxant that can kill. The drug was detected by a new test developed by toxicologist Dr. Bo Holmstedt of Stockholm, Sweden. Defense lawyer Laura Little told
