State rests case against Autumn Hills

SAN ANTONIO — The state rested its rebuttal case in the murder-by-neglect trial of a nursing home corporation Monday after calling two witnesses.
The trial, now in its 22nd week of testimony, shifts to rebuttal testimony by the defense Tuesday.
Autumn Hills Convalescent Centers Inc. and four of its current and former employees are charged with murder by neglect in the Nov. 20, 1978, death of Elnora Breed. Breed, 87, died 47 days after she entered an Autumn Hills nursing home in Texas City.
The state contends she died of infection and starvation, both caused by poor nursing care. The defense says Breed died of a recurring cancer.
Prosecutors indicated last week they might call as many as a dozen witnesses during rebuttal. But Monday, Galveston County District Attorney Mike Guarino told State District Judge Don Morgan the state would rest.
"We just felt it would be too repetitious" to call more witnesses, he said after court was adjourned for the day.
The final prosecution rebuttal witness was Julius Bridges, a Medicaid fraud investigator for the state attorney general's office.
Bridges said he investigated allegations of staffing falsifications at an Autumn Hills home in Texas City in May and June of 1978.
Autumn Hills officials have testified they discovered the administrator of the nursing home was falsifying staffing reports used for Medicaid reimbursements. The administrator was fired.

Chagra given 30 years for conspiring to kill federal judge

SAN ANTONIO — A tearful Elizabeth Chagra, twice convicted of plotting to kill a federal judge, was sentenced to 30 years in prison Monday after a prosecutor said she had shown "absolutely no sign of remorse."
Chagra, 32, was convicted Feb. 27 of conspiring to kill U.S. District Judge John H. Wood Jr., who was

gunned down shortly before he was scheduled to preside over her husband's drug smuggling trial.
Defense attorney Warren Burnett said after U.S. District Judge William Sessions pronounced the sentence, "I thought it was a grisly, grisly bit of work on the part of the judge."
"I was quite disappointed. She's been a splendid prisoner and has been rehabilitated. Both of these factors should have been taken into consideration."
Chagra showed no reaction as Sessions announced the sentence.
She will be eligible for parole in 1992, according to federal prosecutors.
Chagra was convicted of conspiracy in 1982 and ordered to serve 30 years in prison. But an appeals court in 1985 overturned the conviction and ordered a new trial.

Wood was shot down outside San Antonio home May 29. Known as "Maximum John," a stiff sentences, he had been ruled to preside over a drug case involving Chagra's husband, James Chagra testified she did \$250,000 to Charles Harrelson is serving a life sentence for judge's murder. But she said she thought the money was for her husband's gambling debts.
