Mauro favors loan to farmers making less than \$250,000

Texas Land Commissioner Gary Mauro said Wednesday at a public hearing that he favors making loans only to farmers and ranchers who make less than \$250,000 per year.

Mauro, speaking in Rudder Tower, said, "The Legislature took two sessions to pass the (Texas Farm and Ranch Finance Program). At one time it was \$350,000. As a compromise measure, it was brought down to \$250,000.

"I've come to think that \$250,000 might work. But in the Legislature, that was a big sticky point."

The purpose of the hearing, which about 30 people attended, was to allow the public to comment and make suggestions on the rules and regulations of the new loan program.

All comments will be considered before the regulations are voted on in May, Mauro said.

Under the program, which is administered by the Veterans Land Board, Texas farmers and ranchers can borrow up to \$100,000 to buy a minimum of 50 acres of land with a 5 percent down payment. The program is limited to Texas residents of five years or more involved with Texas agriculture for the past three years. They must show 35 percent of their gross income comes from agriculture and their net worth is \$250,000 or less.

Mauro also said that he knew where the line should be drawn in defining what agricultural fields should qualify for a program.

"It's pretty clear that we need that's the manager of a farm, paid a salary, probably quite small. But what happens to that works for the feed store town as a clerk? That is a question."

The board may set priorities for eligibility to apply for and let county committees make the final decision, Mauro said.

Each committee will be chosen by the county judge, and two members involved in agriculture and one member will be a local land agent, he said.

Death row prisoner wins appeal for retrial

HUNTSVILLE (AP) — Death row inmate Larry Keith Robison, who had asked his appeals be halted and his execution be carried out, won a new retrial Wednesday when the Texas Court of Criminal Appeals threw out his capital murder conviction.

The victim, Bruce Gardner, 33, was robbed and killed on Aug. 10, 1982, at a Lake Worth cottage. Three other people were slain in the house and a fourth, Ricky Lee Bryant — Robison's roommate — was found dead in a house next door.

Among the five victims was a boy, 11.

Robison, after learning of the court decision, said, "Am I guilty? I did the crime. Whether I'm guilty of capital murder, that's for a jury to decide."

Robison, 28, a carpenter born in Abilene, was tried only once in the killing, according to defense attorney Charles Roach of Fort Worth. He said a retrial was likely.

Robison's trial was held in a Dallas courtroom. He said the judge's decision was insanity.

"Am I crazy? I have come to realize that's what the judge said, back now, I didn't know what I was doing at the time."

In Austin, the Court of Criminal Appeals, in a 6-3 vote, said the conviction must be reversed. State District Judge Charles B. Walker of Fort Worth erred in agreeing to a prosecution objection to a defense lawyer asked a juror.

The question dealt with the prospective juror had about insanity as a defense charge.

Hurricane service director: Better technology needed

HOUSTON (AP) — Hurricane forecasters need more advanced technology to better predict potentially deadly paths of tropical storms and protect coastal residents, the director of the National Hurricane Center said Wednesday.

Neil Frank said that until such technology is developed, there should be backup emergency evacuation plans when unexpected weather conditions occur.

"The biggest nightmare is a weak storm that explosively strengthens,"

Frank said at the Eighth International Hurricane Conference in Houston.

In 1985, eight major hurricanes hit the Gulf of Mexico coast, causing more than \$1 billion in damage, Frank said.

Frank said it would be unwise for such a busy season to hit again in 1986.

Hurricane Elena caused the largest evacuation ever — one million people on the Mexico coast had to leave their homes to be evacuated to inland areas.
