'White oil' case has 1st hearing in appeals court

AUSTIN (AP) — The high-stakes "white oil" controversy was presented Wednesday to the 3rd Court of Appeals, which could rule later this year.

A standing-room crowd of more than 50 people, mostly lawyers, packed the court chamber for a hearing that could resolve ownership of perhaps \$25 billion in oil and gas resources in the Panhandle Field.

The commission adopted last May requiring retesting of oil wells without use of LTX, to see if the wells could still produce oil production standard.

White oiler operators sued district court in Austin and the case then was appealed to the Court of Appeals. Some white oil operators already have been halted production on certain wells.

On Wednesday, lawyer of McKinney, representing oil producers, said nowhere in law does it say what color oil be.

Boyd said the commission sent out "conflicting signals late 1977 over whether it could be counted as crude oil."

Assistant Attorney General Rangel, representing the state, said if white oil operators their way, an operator could turn a well into an oil well by turning on or off an LTX.

The operators counted the water-white liquid as crude oil in meeting the Railroad Commission's test for an oil well — production of at least one barrel of oil per 100,000 cubic feet of gas.

An oil well can be drilled on 10 acres, a gas well on 640 acres so there is an economic incentive to a well being classified as an oil well. Also, major companies such as Phillips Petroleum own gas rights in the Panhandle-field and independents own much of the oil rights.

Phillips, which complained to the Railroad Commission about white oil operations in 1981, says experts believe the current gas supply in the Panhandle Field will run out in three years.

"This would have a tremendous impact on the commission's preventive rights," Rangel said.

P.M. Schenkan, an Austin attorney representing Anadarko Petroleum Co. and others, said if operators allowed to count white oil as oil, it would wipe out the commission's well classification and preventive rights.
