## Mattox says ruling will aid execution process in Texas

AUSTIN (AP) — The U.S. Supreme Court's decision Monday allowing death penalty opponents to be barred from capital murder case juries means Texas executions can move forward at a quicker pace, Attorney General Jim Mattox said.

Among others, the decision applies to the case of Jay Kelly Pinkerton, who is scheduled to die by lethal injection on May 15, Mattox said.

The high court, voting 6-3, decided the Arkansas case which had raised questions about dismissal of such jurors. Texas and 37 other states had filed written arguments on Arkansas' behalf.

In its ruling, the Supreme Court said the Constitution doesn't prohibit removal of prospective capital murder case jurors who state they oppose the death penalty.

Assistant Attorney General Paula Offenhauer said that argument had been raised in appeals filed by several convicted murderers in Texas.

Pinkerton was sentenced to die for the 1979 mutilation murder of Sarah Donn Lawrence in Amarillo. An apprentice meat cutter, Pinkerton also was convicted of the 1972 slaying of Sherry Welch in Amarillo.

Pinkerton had faced an Aug. 1985 execution, but he was granted a last-minute stay by the Supreme Court pending the outcome of the Arkansas case.

Mattox said, "The Pinkerton case is the most immediate to be affected by today's Supreme Court decision. In its decision, the Supreme Court said fair-trial rights are not violated when death penalty opponents are excluded, for that reason, frontiers that will decide guilt or innocence in cases in which death is a possible sentence.

The decision reversed a last-minute appeals court ruling that said that all potential jurors who were excluded never impose a death sentence creates a "conviction by jury — and thus violates a defendant's right to a fair trial."

- Mt. Aggie Sno Cones** at 125 University in College Station was inspected by David Plett. Score — 94. The report cited a four-point violation for a door that did not close and was not weathers-tripped properly. Another two points were deducted from the report for garbage and water that needed to be removed.
- Subway Sandwiches & Salads** at 913 C Harvey Road in College Station was inspected by Mike Lester. Score — 92. Two two-point deductions were made from the report for food stored on the floor and a meat slicer that needed cleaning. The report

- Los Nortenos** at 201 S. Main in Bryan was inspected by David Plett. Score — 83. Four points were deducted in the report because a hand sink was inaccessible. Another four points were subtracted in the report because cockroaches were in the kitchen area, some electrical conduit around a dishwasher needed sealing, a screen door needed repairing and weatherstripping, and a screen over a vent fan needed repairing. Two two-point violations were cited in the report for some food stored on a floor.
