Texas sheriff gets bond of \$50,000 in child porn case

DALLAS (AP) — A federal magistrate Thursday set a \$50,000 bond for Montague County Sheriff Harry Walker, who is charged with mailing a pornographic photograph of a child.
 Walker, who waived a right to a preliminary hearing, remained in the Lew Sterrett Justice Center after two days of a detention hearing.
 According to Nancy Smith, secretary to U.S. Magistrate William Sanderson Jr., who set the bond, if Walker is bailed out of jail, he will be able to leave Montague County only to consult with lawyers or for court appearances and he will be forbidden to be in the presence of minors except with the permission and the presence of their parents.
 U.S. Assistant Attorney Denver McCarty, the prosecutor, filed a motion to deny bond to Walker and said he would appeal the bond if Walker was able to post it.
 In Thursday's bond hearing, some of Walker's descriptions and a friend testified in his behalf, telling the court that Walker would abide by bail provisions, Smith said.
 In Wednesday's testimony, Dallas police investigator testified that man fitting Walker's description paid a boy \$50 to pose in pornographic pictures. The boy said he got into a car with him and went to Dallas motel, where the photographs were taken and oral sex was performed on him.
 Dallas police investigator J. MacDonald said Wednesday he found and talked with a young man shown in pornographic photographs found during a search of Walker's home last week by U.S. authorities and FBI agents.
