A final decision on whether to approve the merger is still planned by Aug. 31, department spokesman Alan Pollock said.

Critics of the Texas Air-Eastern deal have complained that such a merger would severely reduce competition along the heavily traveled Northeast "shuttle" corridor linking Washington, New York and Boston.

Eastern Airlines and New York Air, which also is owned by Texas Air Corp., currently dominate and compete vigorously in the shuttle market. Last month, Texas Air announced it was selling some operating rights held by New York Air at Washington and New York to Pan American World Airways so Pan Am can begin competing shuttle service next October
